


# *BEAUTIFUL: THE CAROLE KING MUSICAL & MAN OF LA MANCHA IN SEATTLE*

## See a new musical and a 1960s musical revival in one long weekend!

***Beautiful: The Carole King Musical*** tells the story of the early life and career of Carole King, using songs that she wrote, often together with Gerry Goffin, and other contemporary songs by Barry Mann, Cynthia Weil, and Phil Spector. The original production of *Beautiful* received its world premiere in San Francisco in 2013 and moved to Broadway in January 2014. The London production began in February 2015. Both Broadway and London shows are scheduled to play into 2017. *Beautiful* has won two Tony Awards, three Drama Desk Awards, two Laurence Olivier Awards, and a Grammy Award. Seattle is the nearest city where you can see *Beautiful* during its 2016 national tour.

***Man of La Mancha*** is a 1964 musical inspired by Cervantes' 17<sup>th</sup> century masterpiece, *Don Quixote*. The original Broadway production ran for 2,328 performances and won five Tony Awards, including Best Musical. The show has been revived four times on Broadway, becoming one of the most enduring works of musical theatre. Its best known song is *The Impossible Dream*.

## Itinerary

- Thursday, October 27:** Meals: L  
We follow the Coquihalla to the lower mainland, then cross the border at Sumas. Our destination is Lynnwood on the north side of Seattle where we settle into the **Embassy Suites Hotel** for three nights. Consistently rated as one of our top lodgings, the hotel had a multi-million dollar renovation completed in spring 2016. It features a large plant-filled atrium, a full cooked-to-order breakfast each morning, and a manager's reception with complimentary cocktails and snacks each evening.
- Friday, October 28:** Meals: B  
Our day starts at Pacific Science Center where we see the International Exhibition of **Sherlock Holmes**. Holmes was a scientific expert ahead of his time, and used seemingly trivial observations of clues others had missed to solve some of his era's most mysterious crimes. His practices and techniques, created by author Conan Doyle, changed the way police work was conducted and some are still in use today. There is time for
- lunch and shopping at the popular **Pike Place Market**, then we return to Lynnwood with a dropoff at Alderwood Mall for anyone who wants more shopping. Join your new Wells Gray friends at the hotel for complimentary beverages starting at 5:30. Tonight, we go to the Paramount Theatre to see **Beautiful: The Carole King Musical** starting at 8 pm.
- Saturday, October 29:** Meals: B  
In the morning, we stroll through the magnificent **Chihuly Garden and Glass**. Founded on the international success of glass artist Dale Chihuly, the facility features many of his most popular works and architectural installations. Then we go to the ornate 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Theatre for the matinee performance of **Man of La Mancha**. Back at the Embassy Suites, relax over cocktails and snacks.
- Sunday, October 30:** Meals: B,L  
We stop at the Duty Free Store and cross the border at Sumas. After lunch in Hope, we head for home.

## Tour Policies

**Payments:** A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due September 13, 2016.  
**Discounts:** Early bookers receive \$60 discount on first 15 seats and \$30 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after September 13.  
**Cancellation Policy:** Up to September 13, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From September 14 to September 27, the cancellation charge is 40% of the tour fare. From September 28 to October 11, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare. After October 11, there is no refund.  
**Fare Changes:** Changes to currency exchange rates and taxes, and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

**Travel Insurance:** A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard.
