



Itinerary

Friday, April 14:

Meals: L

Leaving from Kamloops, Salmon Arm and the Okanagan Valley, we travel the Coquihalla Highway. Lunch is included in Chilliwack. Our overnight stay is at the **Fairmont Hotel Vancouver** on West Georgia Street in downtown Vancouver. Opened in 1939 at a cost of \$12 million, it was a landmark with its copper green roof and a height of 17 storeys. Its public rooms became famous including the Panorama Roof, the Timber Club and the Pacific Empire Ballroom. A \$70 million restoration during the 1990s has brought this magnificent

hotel back to being among the finest in Vancouver. It has an excellent location, surrounded by dozens of interesting shops and restaurants, and a block from Pacific Centre Mall. There is free time if you wish to meet relatives or friends for an early dinner. A transfer is provided to the Queen Elizabeth Theatre and **Cinderella** starts at 7:30 pm.

Saturday, April 15:

Savour the Fairmont's superb breakfast buffet! We depart in mid-morning for the return drive to the Interior with a stop for lunch in Hope.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due March 1, 2017.

Cancellation Policy: Up to February 1, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From February 2 to March 1, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From March 2 to March 30, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After March 30, there is no refund.

Activity Level: Light activity including short distances to walk and some steps. The coach will drive you to the Queen Elizabeth Theatre and, depending on congestion, will pick you up as close as possible to the theatre afterwards. If you are not able to participate in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.
