Itinerary

Thursday, November 27: Meals: L,D

We ferry across the Strait of Juan de Fuca on the Coho, then drive along the Olympic Peninsula and the Columbia River. Arriving in **Portland**, we check into the **Embassy Suites Hotel** downtown. Built in 1912 as the Multnomah Hotel, it became a government office building during the 1970s and 1980s. A \$20 million restoration brought this beautiful structure back to life as an all-suite hotel in 1998. A two hour cocktail reception each evening starting at 5:30 and a full breakfast each morning are included. Tonight, we celebrate Thanksgiving with our American neighbours with a traditional turkey dinner and pumpkin pie at the hotel.

Friday, November 28: Meals: B
Today is nicknamed the "Biggest Shopping Day of the Year" or "Black Friday" in the USA and provides a great opportunity to finish your Christmas shopping lists. The annual Macy's Thanksgiving Parade begins at 9 am this morning, passing within half a block of our hotel. Don't miss the 26 spectacular floats, magnificent marching bands, and 600 costumed characters. After the parade finsihes, we drive to Clackamas Towne Center where some of budget stores are located: Target, Old Navy and Nordstrom Rack. Or stay downtown

and visit Saks Fifth Avenue, Nordstroms and

Macy's. We return in mid-afternoon, but there is still time to visit downtown treasures such as Powell Books. Tonight, walk over to Pioneer Square for the special Christmas Tree lighting ceremony that signals the start of the festive season.

Saturday, November 29: Meals: B

Our shopping excursion this morning travels south of Portland to Woodburn Company Stores. This ever-growing outlet mall has 110 stores including some hard-to-find outlets such as Chico's, White House/Black Market, and Guess. This afternon, wander through the Portland Saturday Market, a thriving arts and crafts open-air marketplace featuring local food and craft items. After cocktails at the hotel, we enjoy the magical setting at The Grotto's Christmas Festival of Lights, a presentation of spectacular lights, hourly music concerts, ongoing carolling and other family entertainment. Few holiday celebrations compare to the grandeur of this pristine sanctuary garden with its magnificent architecture, towering firs and angel-covered cliffside as a backdrop.

Sunday, November 30: Meals: B
We travel home with our treasure and take the 2
pm Coho ferry back to Victoria.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$100 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due October 23, 2014.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$40 discount on first 15 seats and \$20 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after October 23.

Cancellation Policy: Up to October 23, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From October 24 to November 6, the cancellation charge is 40% of the tour fare. From November 7 to November 14, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare. After November 14, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.
