



## Important note about Jasper Park Lodge accommodations:

The main building of Jasper Park Lodge has the lobby, dining rooms, lounge, activity rooms, pool, shops, and a few bedrooms available to guests in wheelchairs or with significant mobility challenges. You are staying in rooms located around the extensive parklike grounds in individual cabins, duplexes, or small motel-like buildings. Junior suites may offer a lake view, but Fairmont and deluxe categories do not have a view. Most rooms are a 5-10 minute leisurely walk to the main building but, if you prefer not to walk, a very efficient shuttle service operates on request from your room to the main building and back. If you qualify for a room in the main building, we can ask about availability at the time of booking.

**Please note that Fairmont rooms, deluxe rooms and junior suites are NOT in the main building.**

## Itinerary

### Monday, October 3:

*Meals: L*

Heading east along the Trans-Canada Highway, we enjoy the unparalleled scenery of Glacier, Yoho and Banff National Parks. After crossing the continental divide at Kicking Horse Pass, we stay overnight at the Lake Louise Inn.

### Tuesday, October 4:

*Meals: B,L,D*

First, we drive up to Lake Louise, nestled below glacier-shrouded peaks. Then we enjoy the drive along the **Icefields Parkway**, one of Canada's most spectacular highways. The highlight of the day is admiring the vast **Columbia Icefields** that feed water to three oceans. Other stops include Sunwapta Falls and Athabasca Falls. In mid-afternoon, we arrive at splendid **Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge** for our three-night getaway experience. An advance list of the activities is available close to departure, then sign up for the ones you are interested in after arrival. They may include hikes, yoga, lectures on history, nature, or photography; soapstone carving, or jewelry making. A welcome reception (drinks included) is followed by dinner in the elegant Beauvert Dining Room.

### Wednesday, October 5:

*Meals: B,L,D*

A breakfast buffet is served in the Beauvert Room,

and you can come at your leisure from 7:30 on. Then enjoy the activities you chose for today. Take a historical tour of the lodge. Meet the kitchen magicians who create the awesome food choices. Kick up your heels with line dancing. Our coach provides a transfer into Jasper if you wish to shop or visit nearby attractions. Lunch is at noon in the Beauvert Room. There is a games room to use at your leisure during the day, plus there is always the luxurious option of booking a spa treatment. Happy hour is at 5:30, followed by another fabulous dinner, a movie and sing-a-long.

### Thursday, October 6:

*Meals: B,L,D*

This is another full day of activities, or leisure time as you wish. The final night is a gala affair, with special musical entertainment and dancing after your feast in the Beauvert Room.

### Friday, October 7:

*Meals: B,L*

We say farewell to Jasper Park Lodge and travel west along the Yellowhead Highway past **Mount Robson**, highest in the Canadian Rockies. There is a side trip into Wells Gray Park to see 75-metre tall **Spahats Falls**, and lunch is in Clearwater. Then we follow the North Thompson River into Kamloops and continue to the Okanagan.

## Tour Policies

**Payments:** A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due August 17, 2016.

**Discounts:** Early bookers receive \$60 discount on first 15 seats and \$30 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after August 17.

**Cancellation Policy:** Up to August 17, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From August 18 to September 2, the cancellation charge is 30% of the tour fare. From September 3 to September 16, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After September 16, there is no refund.

**Fare Changes:** Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

**Travel Insurance:** A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. **Activity Level:** Light activity including short distances to walk and some steps. See the accommodation note above regarding location of Jasper Park Lodge rooms. Your room is not located in the main building. If you are not able to participate in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

**Experience Points:** This tour earns 29 points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points. One point equals \$1. Redeem your points on select tours or accumulate enough points to earn a free tour! Redemptions offered until August 17.
