



The Phantom returns to Spokane

One of the most famous musicals of all time, **The Phantom of the Opera**, was created by composer Andrew Lloyd Webber and lyricists Charles Hart and Richard Stilgoe. It opened at Her Majesty's Theatre in London in 1986 with Michael Crawford and Sarah Brightman in the leading roles. The Broadway production at New York's Majestic Theatre opened in 1988 and is still playing 28 years later, making it the longest running Broadway show in history with over 11,335 performances. It is estimated that over 130 million people have seen the show in 27 countries and the box office gross world-wide stands at \$5.6 billion. It has won over 50 awards including the Laurence Olivier and Evening Standard Award for Best Musical, seven Tony Awards, seven Drama Desk Awards and three Outer Critic Circle Awards. The touring production coming to Spokane has been hailed by critics as "bigger and better than ever before" and features a brilliant new scenic design, new costume designs, updated lighting, and new choreography. It boasts many exciting special effects including the show's legendary chandelier, the burning stage, floating candelabras, and the paddle across the lake. The beloved story and thrilling score will be performed by a cast and orchestra of 52, making this *Phantom* one of the largest on tour.

Many people have seen **The Phantom of the Opera** before. Come and relish the music, singing, sets, and story once again. Enjoy the wonderful songs such as *Music of the Night*, *All I Ask of You*, *Masquerade*, *Wishing You Were Somehow Here Again*, *Angel of Music*, and *The Point of No Return*.

Itinerary

Wednesday, July 5:

Meals: L

We leave the Okanagan Valley via Highway #33 to the West Kootenays and have lunch in historic Greenwood. We cross the border near Grand Forks and travel south along the Kettle and Columbia Rivers to reach **Spokane**. We stay two nights at RL Hotel at the Park (formerly Red Lion), located next to Riverfront Park.

Thursday, July 6:

Meals: B,D

With the benefit of a local guide, we enjoy a city tour including Spokane Falls, Riverfront Park, the stunning mansions on "The Hill", majestic **Saint John's Cathedral**, and the Conservatory in Manito

Park. For those interested, a transfer is provided to the downtown core for shopping opportunities. Dinner is at the unique **Steam Plant Grill**. Built in 1915 to provide steam heat and power for downtown Spokane, it closed in 1986 and was converted in the mid-1990s to a collection of shops and restaurants with a fascinating ambiance. The curtain rises at 7:30 pm for the performance of **The Phantom of the Opera** at the INB Theatre.

Friday, July 7:

Meals: B

We return to the Okanagan and Kamloops with stops at immense Grand Coulee Dam and the Duty-Free Store at the Osoyoos border crossing.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due May 18, 2017.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$40 discount on first 15 seats and \$20 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after May 18.

Cancellation Policy: Up to May 18, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From May 19 to June 1, the cancellation charge is 40% of the tour fare. From June 2 to June 15, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare. After June 15, there is no refund.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment.
