Tsa-kwa-luten Lodge

Magnificent Tsa-kwa-luten Lodge was built by the Kwagiutl people and its vast lobby resembles a traditional "Big House" with massive timbers, a soaring cathedral ceiling, and huge windows overlooking Discovery Passage. All rooms have an ocean view. Relax on your private balcony and enjoy the panorama of the ocean, the mountains of Vancouver Island beyond, the rapidly-moving tides, and the tugboats with barges navigating this narrow waterway. There is also a two-bedroom beachfront cottage available if you are sharing with two or three other passengers. Meals are served in the main dining room which has an entrancing view, and all meals are included due to the isolation of the lodge. There are walking trails along the waterfront to the lighthouse, and a more difficult trail to the bluff at Cape Mudge with a view south into the Strait of Georgia. It's a wonderful place to celebrate Canadian Thanksgiving.

Itinerary

Saturday, October 7:

Meals: L

After driving the Coquihalla, we take the 3 pm ferry from Tsawwassen to Duke Point. We stay overnight in downtown Nanaimo at the Best Western Dorchester Hotel.

Sunday, October 8:

Meals: B,D

We stroll by the ocean at Rath Trevor Beach near Parksville, then take a short walk through the forest to the high bridge over Englishman River Falls. There is shopping time at unique **Coombs Market**, known for its goats grazing on the roof. At Campbell River, we take the 10-minute ferry ride over to **Quadra Island** where we stay for two nights at **Tsa-kwa-luten Lodge**. A traditional Thanksgiving turkey dinner is served tonight.

Monday, October 9:

Meals: B,L,D

Happy Thanksgiving Day! At **Rebecca Spit**, we take a pleasant walk along a beach with the ocean on both sides. The afternoon is at leisure to wander the beach in front of the hotel, walk to the cliffs at the south end of Quadra Island, or just relax around the lodge.

Tuesday, October 10:

Meals: B,L

We take a morning ferry back to Campbell River, then drive the Island Highway with a lunch stop in Parksville at the Beach Club. After riding the ferry to Horseshoe Bay, we stay overnight at the downtown Blue Horizon Hotel. A theatre show is included tonight, but productions for October have not been released as of February 2017.

Wednesday, October 11:

Meals: L

After lunch in Hope, we travel home along the Coquihalla Highway.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due August 24, 2017.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$50 discount on first 15 seats and \$25 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after August 24. BC seniors (65 & over) receive a \$6 discount extended by BC Ferries, so you must bring your BC Gold Care Card or the new Services Card.

Cancellation Policy: Up to August 24, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From August 25 to September 6, the cancellation charge is 40% of the tour fare. From September 7 to September 21, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After September 21, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.

 **Activity Level:** Light activity including short distances to walk, some walking on sandy or pebbly beaches, and some steps. If you stay in a beachfront cottage at Tsa-kwa-luten, there is a 5-minute walk uphill to the lodge for meals and the coach. If you are not able to participate in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

e-points: This tour earns 22 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One e-point equals \$1. Redeem your points on select tours or accumulate enough points to earn a free tour! Redemptions offered until August 24.
