Cirque du Soleil was founded in 1984 in Gaspé as part of the celebrations around the 450th anniversary of Jacques Cartier's arrival in Quebec. Cirque was based on a totally new concept: a striking, dramatic mix of the circus arts and street entertainment, featuring outrageous costumes, staged under magical lighting with original music, and not one animal. With its fame growing across Canada (including a performance at Expo '86), Cirque offered its first show in California in 1987 and became an overnight success. The Mirage Resort in Las Vegas signed Cirque to a year-long contract in 1992. Today, Cirque du Soleil has about 4,000 employees with headquarters still in Montreal, and 19 shows with different themes are currently performing around the world. Over 90 million people have seen a Cirque show since 1984. We have excellent seats in the Grand Chapiteau in Section 201 Rows H to L.

Salute to Vienna has been billed as the world's greatest New Year's concert. For over 60 years, the Vienna Philharmonic's "Neujahrskonzert" broadcast has thrilled 1.2 billion people annually around the globe – a joyous celebration of the musical legacy of Johann Strauss Jr. In 1995, concert producers, Attila and Marion Glatz, presented their first *Salute to Vienna* in Toronto and it was modelled carefully after the original. Now, 22 years later, the show has become a New Year's tradition in North America featuring glorious music performed by the Vancouver Symphony with an outstanding cast of 75 musicians, singers and dancers. The show is staged almost simultaneously in 21 cities throughout Canada and the United States. We have reserved superb seats at the ornate Orpheum Theatre in Right and Left Centre Orchestra Rows 11 to 13.

Itinerary

Saturday, December 30:

Meals: L

We drive to Vancouver and stay three nights at the renowned **Fairmont Hotel Vancouver**. Opened in 1939 at a cost of \$12 million, it was the third Hotel Vancouver and a downtown landmark with its copper green roof and a height of 17 storeys. A \$12 million renovation in 2014 has brought this magnificent hotel back to being among the finest in Vancouver. The Hotel Vancouver has an excellent location on West Georgia Street, surrounded by dozens of shops and restaurants, and a block from Pacific Centre Mall.

Sunday, December 31:

Meals: B,D

Start the day with the Fairmont's fabulous breakfast buffet. Then we go to Canada Place to experience **Fly Over Canada**. Soar from coast to coast on a breathtaking aerial journey using the latest in virtual flight ride technology. This is a fully immersive experience including wind, scents, mist, and state-of-the-art sound.

Option: If you have previously seen Fly Over Canada and prefer to do something else, you can opt out and your fare will be reduced \$16.

Later, we go to the Grand Chapiteau and thrill to **Cirque du Soleil's Kurios**, starting at 1:30 pm. A three-course New Year's Dinner is included in Gastown at the popular Steamworks Grill. Back at the hotel, you may want to ring in the New Year in the lounge at midnight.

Monday, January 1, 2018:

Meals: B

At 2 pm, we go to the Orpheum Theatre to enjoy the annual performance of **Salute to Vienna**. Here is a welcome message from the creators of the world's greatest New Year's concert, Attila and Marion Glatz:

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due October 27, 2017.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$60 discount on first 15 seats and \$30 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after October 27.

Cancellation Policy: Up to October 27, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From October 28 to November 23, the cancellation charge is 40% of the tour fare. From November 24 to December 8, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare. After December 8, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Activity Level: Light activity including short distances to walk and some steps, mainly to and from your seats in the Grand Chapiteau and Queen Elizabeth Theatre. There is a walk of nearly 2 blocks along the length of Canada Place to Fly Over Canada. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.
