

The Book of Mormon — a hot ticket on Broadway and in London!

The Book of Mormon is a religious satire musical that lampoons organized religion and traditional musical theatre, reflecting the playwrights' lifelong fascination with Mormonism and musicals. The story follows two young Mormon missionaries sent to a remote village in northern Uganda, where a brutal warlord is threatening the local population. Naive and optimistic, the two missionaries try to share the Book of Mormon, which only one of them knows very well, but have trouble connecting with the locals, who are more worried about war, famine, poverty, and AIDS than about religion. *The Book of Mormon* features book, music and lyrics by Trey Parker, Robert Lopez, and Matt Stone. Parker and Stone are the four-time Emmy Award-winning creators of the landmark animated series, *South Park*. Tony Award-winner Lopez is co-creator of the long-running hit musical comedy, *Avenue Q*.

The Book of Mormon opened on Broadway in 2011 and swept the Tony Awards, winning nine including Best Musical. It is still playing on Broadway seven years later. The London production has been on stage for four years and several touring shows have been mounted. You do not want to miss this show.

Please note that the show contains explicit language and subject matter that may not be enjoyable to all viewers.

Itinerary

Tuesday, September 25:

After pickups around Greater Victoria, we take the 11 am ferry to Tsawwassen. We stay for two nights at the Listel Hotel which enjoys an excellent location on Robson Street with lots of shopping and restaurants nearby. Tonight, there is an option to see ***The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time*** at the Stanley Theatre.

Wednesday, September 26: *Meals: L*

We drive to New Westminster and board the paddlewheeler *MV Native* for a 2½ hour voyage on the Fraser River. Enjoy a delicious lunch while watching an ever-changing view of British Columbia's longest river. We cruise up the river to Surrey

passing under the Pattullo Bridge, Skytrain Bridge and the giant 10-lane Port Mann Bridge which is the longest cable-supported bridge in North America. We see the Douglas Island Wildlife Preserve and the mouth of the Pitt River. A knowledgeable narrator has lots of amusing and interesting stories of the Fraser River's past and present. The rest of the afternoon is free time in case you want to visit with friends or relatives. Tonight, we go to the Queen Elizabeth Theatre to see ***The Book of Mormon***, starting at 8 pm.

Thursday, September 27:

We take the noon ferry back to Victoria.

Option — *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time*

This mystery drama is at the Stanley Theatre on Tuesday, September 25 at 7:30 pm. The plot surrounds the death of a neighbour's dog that is investigated by young Christopher Boone who has an autism condition. The story also explores Christopher's relationships with his parents and school mentor. The play premiered in London in 2012 and won seven Olivier Awards, finally closing in 2017. The Broadway production ran for two years and won the Tony Award for Best Play, the Drama Desk Award for Outstanding Play, and the Outer Critics Circle Award for Outstanding New Broadway Play.

Cost is \$60 per person plus GST. Includes show ticket and transportation to and from the theatre. Please book this option no later than at final payment.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due August 2, 2018. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$40 discount on first 15 seats and \$20 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after August 2. BC seniors (65 & over) receive \$12 discount extended by BC Ferries, so you must bring your BC Gold Care Card or the new Services Card.

Cancellation Policy: Up to July 2, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From July 3 to August 2, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person. From August 3 to August 22, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After August 22, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: Policies for Comprehensive and Trip Cancellation & Interruption are available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies must be purchased no later than at final payment.

 **Activity Level:** Light activity including short distances to walk and some steps, mainly to and from your theatre seats. There is a short level walk from the coach to the vessel. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require ongoing assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense. Travel insurance will probably not cover you.

e-points: This tour earns 20 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One e-point equals \$1. Redeem your points on tours over 3 days. You can accumulate enough points to earn a free tour (this tour eligible until August 2).
