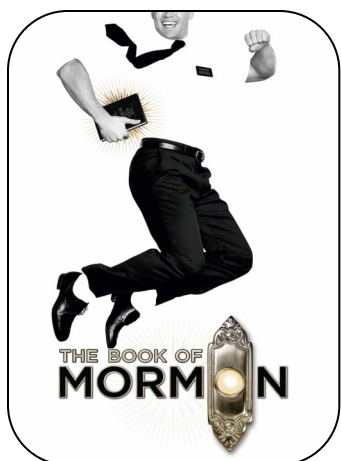

### *The Book of Mormon* — a hot ticket on Broadway!

*The Book of Mormon* is a religious satire musical that lampoons organized religion and traditional musical theatre, reflecting the playwrights' lifelong fascination with Mormonism and musicals. The story follows two young Mormon missionaries sent to a remote village in northern Uganda, where a brutal warlord is threatening the local population. Naive and optimistic, the two missionaries try to share the Book of Mormon, which only one of them knows very well, but have trouble connecting with the locals, who are more worried about war, famine, poverty, and AIDS than about religion. *The Book of Mormon* features book, music and lyrics by Trey Parker, Robert Lopez, and Matt Stone. Parker and Stone are the four-time Emmy Award-winning creators of the landmark animated series, *South Park*. Tony Award-winner Lopez is co-creator of the long-running hit musical comedy, *Avenue Q*.

*The Book of Mormon* opened on Broadway in 2011 and swept the Tony Awards, winning nine including Best Musical. It is still playing on Broadway seven years later. The London production has been on stage for four years and several touring shows have been mounted. You do not want to miss this show.

## Itinerary

### Thursday, September 27:

Meals: L

We drive the Coquihalla to Vancouver and stay for two nights at the Century Plaza Hotel which enjoys an excellent location on Burrard Street with lots of shopping and restaurants nearby. Tonight, there is an option to see ***The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time*** at the Stanley Theatre.

### Friday, September 28:

Meals: L

At 11 am, we depart on a Harbour Cruises vessel for a four-hour cruise through Burrard Inlet and **Indian Arm**. Experience this magnificent coastal mountain fjord right in Vancouver's backyard. Old growth forests, pristine waterfalls, various wildlife,

and large waterfront homes are some of the highlights while sailing through the calm, blue waters of Indian Arm. A delicious buffet lunch is served on board and features fresh BC salmon and chicken. The rest of the afternoon is free time in case you want to visit with friends or relatives. A transfer is provided to the Granville Island Market. Tonight, we go to the Queen Elizabeth Theatre to see ***The Book of Mormon***, starting at 8 pm.

### Saturday, September 29:

Meals: L

We depart in late morning and head for home with a lunch stop in Chilliwack.

## Option — *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time*

This mystery drama is at the Stanley Theatre on Thursday, September 27 at 7:30 pm. The plot surrounds the death of a neighbour's dog that is investigated by young Christopher Boone who has autism. The story also explores Christopher's relationships with his parents and school mentor. The play premiered in London in 2012 and won seven Olivier Awards, finally closing in 2017. The Broadway production ran for two years and won the Tony Award for Best Play, the Drama Desk Award for Outstanding Play, and the Outer Critics Circle Award for Outstanding New Broadway Play.

Cost is \$60 per person plus GST. Includes show ticket and transportation to and from the theatre. Please book this option no later than at final payment.

## Tour Policies

**Payments:** A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due August 7, 2018. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

**Discounts:** Early bookers receive \$40 discount on first 15 seats and \$20 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after August 7.

**Cancellation Policy:** Up to July 6, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$150 per person. From July 7 to August 7, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From August 8 to August 24, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After August 24, there is no refund.

**Fare Changes:** Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

**Travel Insurance:** Policies for Comprehensive and Trip Cancellation & Interruption are available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies must be purchased no later than at final payment.

**Activity Level:** Light activity including short distances to walk and some steps, mainly to and from your theatre seats. There is a short walk from the coach to the vessel with a ramp to the dock. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.



**E-points:** This tour earns 21 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One e-point equals \$1. Redeem your points on tours over 3 days. You can accumulate enough points to earn a free tour (this tour eligible until August 7).
