Celebrate the Season with Leavenworth's Lights

The beauty of the Christmas season joins with the quaint Bavarian theme to create a magical experience in Leavenworth. Browse the shops, savour the pastries, and enjoy the entertainment. A few tour notes:

- Early booking is essential for this tour. The Enzian Inn is a popular hotel and there is a high demand for rooms during the Christmas Lights Festival. On October 25, the hotel will take back all our unsold rooms so tour bookings after this time are subject to room availability.
- This tour is deliberately scheduled for a weekday visit to Leavenworth instead of the famed "Light-Up" Saturdays of November 24 and December 1. We do not believe you can enjoy visiting Leavenworth on a day when 30,000 people cram into the town's little square to watch the lights turn on. On these weekends, the shops are so full you can barely move and proper food service in the restaurants is virtually impossible. Instead, by staying in Leavenworth in midweek, you can enjoy uncrowded shops and restaurants, and the Christmas lights which will be on all day and evening. The only weekend attraction you will miss is the actual instant when all the lights are simultaneously illuminated.

Option

On November 27, there is an option to go to Red Tail Canyon Farm for a one-hour sleigh ride "over the meadow and through the woods". The sleighs are pulled by three Draft Horse teams complete with jingling sleigh bells and have warm wool blankets for your comfort. In the event that there is no snow, the ride will be in a horse-drawn wagon. Hot cocoa is served after the ride. Cost is \$29 per person including transportation from Leavenworth and gratuity. Please request this option no later than final payment.

Itinerary

Monday, November 26:

We cross the border at Osoyoos and travel south along the Okanogan and Columbia Rivers to Wenatchee. Soon we arrive in the quaint Bavarian-themed town of **Leavenworth** which is renowned for its enthusiastic celebration of Christmas. All the buildings are decorated and adorned with lights, so in the evening the town seems like a fairyland setting. We stay two nights at the lovely **Enzian Inn**, located across from Leavenworth's town square and convenient to the shops.

Tuesday, November 27:

Meals: B,D

The Enzian's bountiful buffet breakfast is included each morning. Today has been left at leisure for you to enjoy Leavenworth. See option above for a sleigh or wagon ride at Red Tail Canyon Farm. A trip to the Aplets & Cotlets factory in nearby Cashmere is included. As dusk approaches, you can again admire the myriad of Christmas lights. After a Bavarian buffet dinner at the Enzian, we go to the United Methodist Church for a Christmas concert by Leavenworth's acclaimed harpist **Bronn Journey**. Accompanied by wife Katherine's exquisite vocals, the pair have an uncanny ability to bring music to life with animated humour.

Wednesday, November 28:

Meals: B

We drive west across Stevens Pass to the coast. There is time for shopping at Alderwood Mall, then we drive into downtown Seattle and stay overnight at the **historic Hotel Ändra**. Now one of Seattle's premier luxury hotels, the building first opened in 1926 as efficiency apartments and became a boutique hotel in the 1970s, then was completely re-created to become Hotel Ändra. It has an excellent location at the corner of 4th and Virginia, surrounded by shops and restaurants. Tonight, we go to the 5th Avenue Theatre to see **Annie**. Leapin' lizards! The timeless tale of Little Orphan Annie is back, giving the chance to experience this classic musical about never giving up hope. Boasting one of Broadway's most memorable scores, including *It's the Hard-Knock Life*, *Easy Street*, *N.Y.C.*, and ever-optimistic *Tomorrow*, *Annie* is a delightful theatrical experience. It has won seven Tony Awards.

Thursday, November 29:

We stop at **Bellis Fair Mall** in Bellingham and the Duty-Free Store at Sumas, then we cross the border and head home on the Coquihalla.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due October 9, 2018. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$50 discount on first 15 seats and \$25 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after October 9.

Cancellation Policy: Up to October 9, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From October 10 to October 23, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. From October 24 to November 9, the cancellation charge is 80% of the tour fare. After November 9, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to currency exchange rates and taxes, and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard.
