


# THANKSGIVING AT TSA-KWA-LUTEN LODGE

## Tsa-Kwa-Luten Lodge

Magnificent Tsa-Kwa-Luten Lodge was built by the Kwagiutl people and its vast lobby resembles a traditional "Big House" with massive timbers, a soaring cathedral ceiling, and huge windows overlooking Discovery Passage. All rooms have an ocean view. Relax on your private balcony and enjoy the panorama of the ocean, the mountains of Vancouver Island beyond, the rapidly-moving tides, and the tugboats with barges navigating this narrow waterway. There is also a two-bedroom beachfront cottage available if you are sharing with two or three other passengers. Meals are served in the main dining room which has an entrancing view, and all meals are included due to the isolation of the lodge. There are walking trails along the waterfront to the lighthouse, and a more difficult trail to the bluff at Cape Mudge with a view south into the Strait of Georgia. It's a wonderful place to celebrate Canadian Thanksgiving.

## Itinerary

### Saturday, October 6:

We stay overnight at the Century Plaza Hotel. Tonight, we go to the Stanley Theatre to see **The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time**. The story concerns a mystery surrounding the death of a neighbour's dog that is investigated by young Christopher Boone who has an autism condition, and his relationships with his parents and school mentor. The play premiered in London in 2012 and won 7 Olivier Awards, finally closing in 2017. The Broadway production ran for two years and won the Tony Award for Best Play, the Drama Desk Award for Outstanding Play, and the Outer Critics Circle Award for Outstanding New Broadway Play.

### Sunday, October 7:

*Meals: D*

We ride the ferry from Horseshoe Bay to Nanaimo and drive north on the Inland Island Highway. At Campbell River, we take the 10-minute ferry ride over to **Quadra Island** where we stay for two nights at **Tsa-Kwa-Luten Lodge**.

### Monday, October 8:

*Meals: B,L,D*

Happy Thanksgiving Day! At **Rebecca Spit**, we

take a pleasant walk along a beach with ocean on both sides. We also visit **Nuyumbalees Cultural Centre** (if open) which contains exquisite displays about the life of the Cape Mudge First Nations. The afternoon is at leisure to wander the beach in front of the hotel, walk to the cliffs at the south end of Quadra Island, or just relax around the lodge. A traditional Thanksgiving turkey dinner is served tonight.

### Tuesday, October 9:

*Meals: B,L*

After riding the late morning ferry back to Campbell River, we take a short walk through the forest to the high bridge over Englishman River Falls. There is shopping time at unique **Coombs Market**, known for its goats grazing on the roof. We stay overnight at Coast Bastion Inn in Nanaimo.

### Wednesday, October 10:

*Meals: B*

We take the ferry to Tsawwassen and travel home.

Home pickups and drop-offs are available within Metro Vancouver for a small additional cost.

## Tour Policies

**Payments:** A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due August 23, 2018. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

**Discounts:** Early bookers receive \$60 discount on first 15 seats and \$30 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after August 23. BC seniors (65 & over) receive a \$6 discount extended by BC Ferries, so you must bring your BC Gold Care Card or the new Services Card.

**Cancellation Policy:** Up to August 23, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From August 24 to September 3, the cancellation charge is 40% of the tour fare. From September 4 to September 17, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare. After September 17, there is no refund.

**Fare Changes:** Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

**Travel Insurance:** A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.



**Activity Level:** Light activity including short distances to walk, some walking on sandy or pebbly beaches, and some steps. If you stay in a beachfront cottage at Tsa-Kwa-Luten, there is a 5-minute walk uphill to the lodge for meals and the coach. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require ongoing assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

**E-points:** This tour earns 27 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One e-point equals \$1. Redeem your points on select tours or accumulate enough points to earn a free tour! Redemptions offered until August 23.
