

Itinerary

Thursday, November 22:

Meals: D

Join the coach and board the 5 pm ferry to Swartz Bay. Enjoy the extensive Pacific Dinner Buffet during the crossing. (Note: Most ferries on this route offer the buffet, but an alternative will be arranged if the ship changes.) We stay four nights at **Chateau Victoria** which has an excellent location downtown near the Inner Harbour.

Friday, November 23:

Meals: B,L

Breakfast is included each morning at Vista 18 atop Chateau Victoria. The morning is free time, then we go to **Abkhazi Garden** for a walk and lunch at the Teahouse. This was the home of Prince Nicholas Abkhazi and his wife Peggy who came to Canada from Georgia (Russia) in 1946 and created these gardens. At the Royal BC Museum, we see the special exhibit, **Egypt: The Time of Pharaohs**. With more than 300 original artifacts, some an astounding 4,500 years old, this exhibition covers all aspects of ancient Egyptian life. See the coffin of Nakht and an exceptional bust of Hatshepsut. A show at the Imax Theatre is next. Tonight, we go to Langham Court Theatre, an intimate stage with 177 seats, and see **Goodnight Mister Tom**. Set during the dangerous build-up to World War II, young William Beech is evacuated to the idyllic English countryside and forges a heart-warming friendship with an elderly recluse, Tom Oakley. All is perfect until William is summoned by his mother back to war-torn London. Winner of the 2013 Laurence Olivier Award for Best Entertainment, this uplifting tale is a true inspiration.

Saturday, November 24:

Meals: B,L

In late morning, we drive over the Malahat to **Chemainus** and enjoy a gourmet buffet lunch at Chemainus Theatre. The show is **Little Women**, Louisa May Alcott's buoyant musical of romantic escapades, sibling rivalries, and Christmas wishes. With their father off to fight in the Civil War, the four March sisters have many imagined and real adventures. As they dream of their futures, encounter growing pains of youth, and rise with courage to face their destiny, the March girls learn the true value of hope and family.

Sunday, November 25:

Meals: B,D

The morning is at leisure. There are two shows this afternoon (please choose one when you book):

1) Rent is at McPherson Theatre. It is a rock musical that tells the story of a group of impoverished young artists struggling to survive and create a life in New York. It ran for 12 years on Broadway and won 4 Tony Awards and 6 Drama Desk Awards.

2) Victoria Symphony is performing at Royal Theatre with a program of music from Mozart, Stravinsky, and Grieg.

Tonight we go to Ambrosia Events Centre for dinner with a show.

Monday, November 26:

Meals: B,L

We take the 11 am ferry to Tsawwassen with the Pacific Buffet being served for lunch (see Nov 22 note).

Home pickups and dropoffs are available on this tour for a small additional cost.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due October 2, 2018. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$60 discount on first 15 seats and \$30 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after October 2. BC seniors (65 & over) receive \$28 discount offered by BC Ferries, so you must bring your BC Gold Care Card or the new BC Services Card.

Cancellation Policy: Up to October 2, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From October 3 to October 18, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. From October 19 to November 1, the cancellation charge is 80% of the tour fare. After November 1, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes or surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore we reserve the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.
