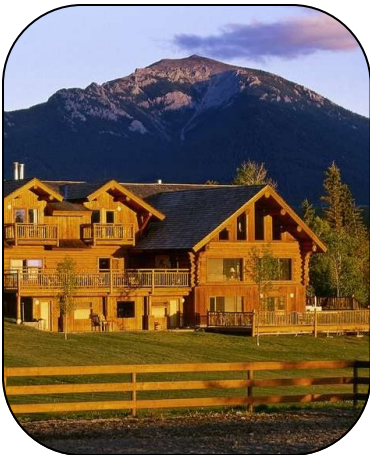

Itinerary

Tuesday, May 21:

Meals: L,D

We follow the Trans-Canada Highway to Cache Creek. Lunch is included at **Ashcroft Manor**, a roadhouse built in 1862 to serve travellers on the Cariboo Wagon Road. We turn onto rural roads at Clinton, heading west into the Marble Range. Arrival at **Echo Valley Ranch & Spa** is about 3 pm. Settle into your rooms, then join an orientation tour of the Ranch at 5 pm. A splendid dinner is served soon after.

Wednesday, May 22:

Meals: B,L,D

Start your first morning at Echo Valley with gentle **Thai Yoga at the Baan Thai**, followed by a delicious group breakfast. The rest of the morning is free to enjoy a cup of coffee and tea, and socialize with others, or you may wish to **relax in the spa** with a soothing session (voucher for a choice of services is provided). We may also be able to join Chef as he goes out on a foraging excursion. This afternoon, we enjoy a short nature walk with an interpreter. Mid-afternoon snacks are available in

the lodge. Dinner is family-style service around a large table, often joined by the ranch owners, Norm and Nan. Later, gather around the **campfire** with the Ranch's working cowboys who find these nights hard to resist! S'mores are at the ready.

Thursday, May 23:

Meals: B,L,D

After Yoga and a hearty breakfast, enjoy more activities for health and wellness that Echo Valley is known for. Special sessions for wine tasting and a Thai cooking class are offered. Many options are available at additional cost including horseback riding, guided fishing, and gold panning. Tonight, a **traditional Thai dinner and dance** are featured.

Friday, May 24:

Meals: B,L

Take in an early Yoga session, then enjoy a leisurely breakfast with departure in mid-morning. Lunch is included at Tobiano Golf Resort overlooking Kamloops Lake. We head home in the afternoon.

Tour notes:

Single rooms are very limited. Early booking is recommended.

Ladies only — This tour is exclusively for ladies. Your tour director is also female and we have requested a female motorcoach driver, but cannot guarantee this.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due March 14, 2019. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$100 discount on first 8 seats and \$50 on next 4 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after March 14.

Cancellation Policy: Up to February 12, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From February 13 to March 14, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From March 15 to April 15, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After April 15, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.

Tour 25: This is a Tour 25 departure, meaning capacity of tour is limited to 25 participants or less, a more intimate travel experience.

Activity Level: You can engage in as much or as little activity as you wish on this tour. There is no elevator in the lodge buildings and your room may be up a flight of stairs. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you are not able to participate in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

E-points: This tour earns 42 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One point equals \$1. Redeem your points on select tours up to final payment date or accumulate enough points to earn a free tour! Redemptions offered until March 14.
