

Come From Away — a Broadway blockbuster finally coming to Vancouver

Come from Away is set in the week following the September 11, 2001, attacks and tells the true story of what transpired when 38 planes were ordered to land unexpectedly in the small town of Gander, Newfoundland. The characters in the musical are based on (and in most cases share the names of) real Gander residents as well as some of the 7,000 stranded travellers they housed and fed. The musical has been received by audiences and critics as a cathartic reminder of the capacity for human kindness in even the darkest of times and the triumph of humanity over hate.

Come from Away had modest beginnings in 2013 at a college theatre in Ontario, then had record-breaking runs in 2015 at La Jolla Playhouse and Seattle Repertory Theatre, and in 2016 at Ford's Theatre in Washington, and Royal Alexandra Theatre in Toronto. It opened on Broadway in March 2017, and became a phenomenal box office success, routinely playing to sold-out audiences. It returned to Toronto in February 2018 and is scheduled to play through April 2019.

At the 71st Tony Awards, *Come from Away* was nominated for seven awards including Best Musical and Best Score, ultimately winning for Best Direction of a Musical. The show has also won five Outer Critics Circle awards, three Drama Desk awards, and four Helen Hayes awards. A feature film is in production.

Itinerary

Saturday, March 9:

After pickups around Greater Victoria, we take the 11 am ferry to Tsawwassen. This afternoon, you have a choice of attractions, either HR MacMillan Space Centre or Vancouver Maritime Museum. We stay for two nights at the Listel Hotel which enjoys an excellent location on Robson Street with lots of shopping and restaurants nearby.

Sunday, March 10:

We visit **VanDusen Botanical Gardens**, a spectacular 22-hectare garden that boasts over 255,000 plants from around the world. Specific garden areas are planted to illustrate botanical relationships, such as the Rhododendron Walk, or geographical origins, as in Sino Himalayan Garden. These areas are set amidst rolling lawns, tranquil lakes and dramatic rockwork with vistas of the mountains and Vancouver cityscape. This after-

noon, we tour **Gulf of Georgia Cannery**, built in 1894. During its peak production at the turn of the 20th century, the cannery produced 2½ million cans of salmon and employed several hundred workers. It has been a National Historic Site since 1984. There is some rest time at the hotel later. Tonight, at 7:30 pm, the curtain rises at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre for *Come From Away*.

Monday, March 11:

We take the 11 am ferry back to Victoria.

Seating for *Come From Away*. We have excellent seats in the Queen Elizabeth Theatre — Centre Orchestra, rows 18 to 22. Seating is assigned from front to back in the order that customers book for this tour.

Options

March 9 — Please choose one of these attractions by final payment date.

(1) HR MacMillan Space Centre. Founded in 1968, this popular astronomy museum offers live demonstrations on science in the GroundStation Canada Theatre, exhibits and games in the Cosmic Courtyard, and shows about astronomy in the Planetarium Star Theatre.

(2) Vancouver Maritime Museum. Explore the maritime history of Vancouver and the BC Coast. See the RCMP vessel *St. Roch* which was the first to sail through the Northwest Passage in 1940-42.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due January 11, 2019. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Cancellation Policy: Up to October 25, 2018, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From October 26, 2018, to January 11, 2019, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From January 12 to February 1, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After February 1, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to currency exchange rates and taxes, and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.

Activity Level: Light activity including short distances to walk and some steps in the theatre and seeing everything in the museums and garden. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you are not able to participate in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.
