Elton John — an entertainment legend for 51 years

Sir Elton Hercules John was born Reginald Dwight in 1947 and burst onto the entertainment scene when he was 20 years old. He has worked with lyricist Bernie Taupin as his songwriting partner since 1967 and they have collaborated on more than 30 albums. Elton John has sold more than 300 million records, making him one of the best-selling music artists in the world. He has more than fifty Top 40 hits, including seven consecutive #1 albums in the U.S.A., 58 Billboard Top 40 singles, and 27 Top 10, including nine which reached #1. *Candle in the Wind*, re-written in 1997 and dedicated to Princess Diana, sold over 33 million copies worldwide and is the best-selling single in the history of the U.K. and U.S.A. singles charts. In 1969, his debut album, *Empty Sky*, was released. Elton John has also achieved success in musical theatre, composing the music for *The Lion King*, *Aida*, and *Billy Elliot*. He has received five Grammy Awards, five Brit Awards, an Academy Award, a Golden Globe Award, a Tony Award, and the Kennedy Center Honors. Elton John was knighted by Queen Elizabeth II for "services to music and charitable services" in 1998 and has performed at a number of royal events such as the funeral of Princess Diana in 1997 and the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Concert in 2012. In early 2018, Elton John announced that he was retiring from touring. His three-year Farewell Yellow Brick Road tour began in September and will consist of over 300 shows on five continents. Vancouver will be one of only five Canadian concerts.

Itinerary

Saturday, September 21:

Meals: L

We drive the Coquihalla to Vancouver and stay two nights at the Century Plaza Hotel which enjoys an excellent location on Burrard Street with lots of shopping and restaurants nearby.

Sunday, September 22:

Meals: L

At 11 am, we depart on a Harbour Cruises vessel for a four-hour cruise through Burrard Inlet and **Indian Arm**. Experience this magnificent coastal mountain fjord right in Vancouver's backyard. Old growth forests, pristine waterfalls, various wildlife, and large waterfront homes are some of the high-

lights while sailing through the calm, blue waters of Indian Arm. A delicious buffet lunch is served on board and features fresh BC salmon and chicken. The rest of the afternoon is free time in case you want to visit with friends or relatives. A transfer is provided to the Granville Island Market. Tonight, we go to Rogers Arena to see **Elton John**, starting at 8 pm.

Monday, September 23:

Meals: L

We depart in late morning and head for home with a lunch stop in Chilliwack.

Seating

Seating is booked in Rogers Arena in Sections 307, 309, 310, 311, 313, 318, 320, and 323.

Important note:

It rarely happens, but performers occasionally get sick, or some mishap causes the cancellation of the concert. This can occur even an hour before the performance begins. We know that this would be extremely disappointing for our customers, but the only refund we would be able to obtain for you would be the actual ticket price for Elton John's concert. The hotel, motorcoach, and other tour services are all prepaid and are non-refundable at short notice.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$400 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due July 18, 2019. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Cancellation Policy: Up to May 17, 2019 your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$200 per person. From May 18 to July 18, the cancellation charge is \$400 per person (your deposit). From July 19 to August 16, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After August 16, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: Policies for Comprehensive and Trip Cancellation & Interruption are available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies must be purchased no later than at final payment.
