Sarah Brightman

Sarah Brightman is a renowned English soprano, songwriter, actress, dancer, and musician. She began her career as a member of the dance troupe Hot Gossip and released several disco singles as a solo performer. In 1981, she made her London musical theatre debut in *Cats* and met composer Andrew Lloyd Webber whom she later married. She went on to star in several London and Broadway musicals, including *The Phantom of the Opera* where she was the first to play Christine Daaé. Her original album of the musical was released in CD format in 1987 and sold 40 million copies worldwide, making it the biggest-selling cast album of all-time. Brightman's 1996 duet with the Italian tenor Andrea Bocelli, *Time to Say Goodbye*, topped the charts all over Europe and became an international success, selling 12 million copies worldwide. She has now collected over 180 gold and platinum record awards in 38 countries. In 2010, she was named by Billboard the fifth most influential and best-selling classical artist of the 2000s. Brightman was the first artist to perform the theme song at the Olympic Games twice — in 1992 in Barcelona where she sang *Amigos Para Siempre* with the Spanish tenor José Carreras, and in 2008 in Beijing, performing *You and Me* with Chinese singer Liu Huan to an estimated audience of four billion.

Brightman's 2019 tour will consist of 125 shows across five continents, but only three will be in Canada in Vancouver, Toronto and Montreal.

Itinerary

Sunday, March 17:

Meals: L

We drive the Coquihalla to Vancouver and stay two nights in the renowned Pan Pacific Hotel, one of the city's most luxurious. It has an excellent location on the waterfront above the Canada Place cruise terminal with lots of shopping and restaurants nearby.

Monday, March 18:

There is a choice of two Vancouver tours this morning. Please select at the time of booking.

- 1) **Forbidden Vancouver Walking Tour.** Mobsters! Opium! Booze! From Victory Square to Chinatown, delve into Vancouver's dirtiest secrets on this scandal-fuelled walking tour past historic landmarks such as Holy Rosary Cathedral, the Dominion Building, the Sun Tower, Woodwards, and the Steam Clock - it's packed with

history and humour. Note that this tour is rated Activity Level 2 (you will be walking 2 km).

- 2) **Vancouver Driving Tour.** A local guide boards our coach and takes you past highlights such as Stanley Park, Chinatown, and Gastown with many interesting stories along the way.

This afternoon, we go to the **Vancouver Aquarium** to view marine life such as beluga whales, Steller sea lions, dolphins, and sea turtles. **Option:** If you have previously been to the aquarium and prefer to do something else, you can opt out and your fare will be reduced \$24.

Tonight, we go to the Queen Elizabeth Theatre to see **Sarah Brightman**, starting at 8 pm.

Tuesday, March 19:

Meals: L

We depart in late morning and head for home with a lunch stop in Chilliwack.

Seating

Seats at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre are in Right and Left Centre, Main Floor, Rows 11-14. Seats are assigned according to the order that you book for this tour.

Important note:

It rarely happens, but performers occasionally get sick, or some mishap causes the cancellation of the concert. This can occur even an hour before the performance begins. We know that this would be extremely disappointing for our customers, but the only refund we would be able to obtain for you would be the actual ticket price for Sarah Brightman's concert. The hotel, motorcoach, and other tour services are all prepaid and are non-refundable at short notice.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due January 30, 2019. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Cancellation Policy: Up to January 3, 2019 your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From January 4 to January 30, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From January 31 to February 12, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After February 12, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: Policies for Comprehensive and Trip Cancellation & Interruption are available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies must be purchased no later than at final payment.

Activity Level: Light activity including short distances to walk and stairs, mainly to and from your theatre seat. The Forbidden Vancouver Walking Tour is rated as Activity Level 2, so do not choose this tour if you have any mobility challenges. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

e-points: This tour earns 21 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One e-point equals \$1. Redeem your points on tours over 3 days. You can accumulate enough points to earn a free tour (this tour eligible until January 30).
