Cirque du Soleil

Cirque du Soleil was founded in 1984 and based on a totally new concept: a striking, dramatic mix of the circus arts and street entertainment, featuring wild, outrageous costumes, staged under magical lighting and set to original music. Today, Cirque du Soleil has about 4,000 employees with headquarters still in Montreal, and 19 shows with different themes are currently performing around the world. Over 90 million people have seen a Cirque show since 1984. Cirque du Soleil's **Luzia** takes you to an imaginary Mexico, like in a waking dream, where light ("luz" in Spanish) quenches the spirit and rain ("lluvia") soothes the soul. **Luzia** offers a surrealistic series of grand visual surprises and breathtaking acrobatic performances. **Luzia** premiered in Montreal in 2016 and has toured the USA and Mexico since then. This is the first visit to Vancouver.

Itinerary

Sunday, December 22:

Meals: L

We drive to Vancouver and stay one night at the Fairmont Waterfront Hotel downtown.

Monday, December 23:

Meals: B,D

Enjoy the Fairmont's bountiful breakfast buffet. The morning is leisure time. Starting at 1:30 pm, we thrill to **Cirque du Soleil's Luzia** at the Grand Chapiteau. Afterwards, we drive to **Harrison Hot Springs Resort** and accommodation is booked in the East Tower for three nights. All guestrooms feature balconies, floor-to-ceiling windows, refrigerators, free wi-fi, and complimentary bathrobes for use during your stay. Join the group for an elegant evening in the renowned **Copper Room**. The three course dinner is followed by dancing and live music with *Hayley & the Lefties Band*.

Tuesday, December 24:

Meals: B,D

Breakfast is included each day in the Lakeside Café. There are plenty of activities to engage you

during a free day today. Schedule a treatment at the exquisite **Healing Springs Spa** with services that range from facials and massages to full body care packages. Take a walk along the lake shore trails. Enjoy afternoon tea at 4 pm in the lobby. And, of course, the hot springs are an enticing and soothing pastime. Dinner is at the Black Forest Restaurant, a five-minute walk along the waterfront promenade.

Wednesday, December 25:

Meals: B,D

Merry Christmas! Expect a gift from Santa during a lovely Christmas breakfast. Relax in the hot pools as long as you wish today. Our gala Christmas Dinner is in the Copper Room with dance music played by the *Jones Boys Band*.

Thursday, December 26:

Meals: B,L

We leave in late morning (time for another visit to the hot pools), and drive home to the Okanagan and Kamloops via the Coquihalla.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$300 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due November 5, 2019. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$80 discount on first 15 seats and \$40 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after November 5.

Cancellation Policy: Up to October 4, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From October 5 to November 5, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person. From November 6 to November 15, the cancellation charge is 50% of tour fare. From November 16 to November 29, the cancellation charge is 80% of the tour fare. After November 29, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.
