## MS Eurodam

**MS Eurodam** made her inaugural cruise in 2008 after being dedicated by Her Majesty Queen Beatrix of the Netherlands. She is Holland America's second largest with a capacity of 2,100 passengers. The Eurodam's gross tonnage is 86,000 and she is 284 metres long. Her 11 decks feature a 1,000-seat live entertainment theatre, nine lounges, casino, shopping arcade, movie theatre, beauty shop, library, games room, Internet centre, spa, gymnasium, and two swimming pools (one with sliding dome cover). The Eurodam has 14 elevators and four of them are glass with panoramic views. An exquisite \$2 million collection of art and artifacts is showcased throughout the ship with a theme of "The Dutch Golden Age".

There are several choices for your dining pleasure. The elegant two-floor **Dining Room** serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner with full choice of menu. The **Lido Market** offers buffet-style serving stations for breakfast, lunch, dinner and the 11 pm snack. The intimate **Pinnacle Grill**, **Canaletto** and **Tamarind** restaurants offer extraordinary service, reserved seating, and gourmet menus for an extra charge. You can dine in the privacy of your stateroom by ordering from the complimentary room service menu.

Every day has a full schedule of optional activities: dance class, bridge, bingo, shuffleboard, table-tennis, karaoke, board games, and fitness activities. The movie theatre presents films daily and, every evening, there is live entertainment in the Mainstage Theatre plus musicians playing in most lounges.

## Itinerary

### Friday, April 10:

Meals: L

We drive to Vancouver and stay overnight at the Blue Horizon Hotel on Robson Street.

### Saturday, April 11:

Meals: L,D

A transfer is provided to the Canada Place cruise terminal. We board the **Eurodam** and an embarkation buffet lunch is served in the Lido. The afternoon is free time to get familiar with the ship. We sail at 5 pm with a festive deck party as we pass under the **Lions Gate Bridge**. Enjoy your first wonderful dinner, followed by a lively stage show or many other evening activities.

### Sunday, April 12:

Meals: B,L,D

Overnight we cruise through the Gulf Islands and dock in **Victoria** from 8 am to 5 pm. A local expert meets us to conduct a fascinating tour of Victoria, focusing on history and unique stories. This afternoon, you may enjoy strolling the Inner Harbour, browsing the shops of Government Street, or visiting local friends and relatives. Tonight, you may wish to dine in the Pinnacle Grill, Canaletto or Tamarind restaurants for a special experience (make a reservation in advance).

### Monday, April 13:

Meals: B,L,D

We round **Cape Flattery** during the night and follow the coast of Washington southward. At 10 am, the **Eurodam** docks at the historic city of **Astoria** at the mouth of the Columbia River. Local tours can be purchased on board. Attractions are the 1885 Flavel Mansion, the spectacular view from the Astoria Column, and the Columbia River Maritime Museum with excellent displays about the river's ecology and history. We sail at 6 pm.

### Tuesday, April 14:

Meals: B,L,D

This is a day at sea. Enjoy the facilities on board.

### Wednesday, April 15:

Meals: B,D

We arrive in **Seattle** and disembark about 9 am. There is time for shopping at giant Alderwood Mall. This afternoon, we drive through Stevens Pass in the Cascade Mountains to the quaint Bavarian-themed town of **Leavenworth**. We stay overnight at the Bavarian Inn, located on Leavenworth's town square and convenient to the shops.

### Thursday, April 16:

Meals: B

We drive along the Columbia River and pristine **Lake Chelan**. A stop is made at the Duty-Free Store at the border before heading home up the Okanagan Valley.

## Tour Policies

**Payments:** A deposit of \$400 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due January 9, 2020. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

**Discounts:** Early bookers receive \$80 discount on first 15 seats and \$40 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after January 9.

**Cancellation Policy:** Up to December 9, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From December 10 to January 9, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person. From January 10 to February 7, the cancellation charge is 40% of the tour fare. From February 8 to March 9, the cancellation charge is 80% of the tour fare. After March 9, there is no refund.

**Fare Changes:** Changes to currency exchange rates and taxes, and surcharges from the cruise line and other tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

**Travel Insurance:** A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment.
