Itinerary

Monday, February 24:

We take a late afternoon ferry from Tsawwassen to Nanaimo and stay overnight at the Coast Bastion Hotel.

Tuesday, February 25:

Meals: B,L,D

We stroll the smooth sands at Rathtrevor Beach and walk among towering firs at **Cathedral Grove**. After lunch in Port Alberni, we drive to the West Coast of Vancouver Island. We stay three nights at the awesome **Wickaninnish Inn** near Tofino. Perched on a rocky point above Chesterman Beach, every room has a splendid ocean view. Maybe you will experience a thrilling winter storm where the spray lashes the windows while you are cuddled comfortably by the fireplace. Tonight, savour an elegant dinner in the Salal Room.

Note: Please make spa appointments for Wednesday or Thursday upon arrival or in advance.

Wednesday, February 26:

Meals: B,L

Breakfast is included at The Wick each day. Low tide is at 8 am, so morning is the best time for beachcombing and peering into tidal pools. We drive into Tofino for some shopping time, followed by lunch. This afternoon, we visit **Long Beach**, the

best known feature of Pacific Rim National Park. Note that the Visitor Centre is closed until March. Dinner is on your own so you can enjoy another tasty experience at the hotel, or the coach provides a transfer into Tofino.

Thursday, February 27:

Meals: B,D

In the morning, we drive to **Ucluelet** and admire the spectacle of big waves hitting the point near Amphitrite Lighthouse. The afternoon is free time at the Wickaninnish Inn. Maybe you have an appointment at the Ancient Cedars Spa. Otherwise, enjoy the fitness centre or a stroll. Dinner is included at the hotel's renowned restaurant, The Pointe.

Friday, February 28:

Meals: B,L,D

We return to the east coast of Vancouver Island and stay overnight at Best Western Chemainus Inn. Take a stroll around the village to admire the colourful murals. Savour a sumptuous buffet dinner at **Chemainus Theatre**, followed by the evening show. The 2020 season will be announced in November.

Saturday, February 29:

Meals: B

We ride the ferry from Duke Point to Tsawwassen.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due December 19, 2019. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$100 discount on first 15 seats and \$50 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after December 19.

Cancellation Policy: Up to November 19, 2019, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From November 20 to December 19, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From December 20 to January 17, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After January 17, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Activity Level: Light activity including short distances to walk and some steps. The walk to Amphitrite Lighthouse is about ½ kilometer, and if you choose not to do this walk, you can enjoy an extended lunch in Ucluelet. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.
