

Celine Dion — an entertainment legend for 39 years

Born into a large family in Quebec, Celine Dion emerged as a teen star with a series of French-language albums during the 1980s. She first gained international recognition by winning both the 1982 Yamaha World Popular Song Festival and the 1988 Eurovision Song Contest. After learning to speak English, she signed on to Epic Records in the USA and, in 1990, released her debut English-language album, *Unison*. During the 1990s, she achieved worldwide fame after releasing several best-selling English albums such as *Falling into You* (1996) and *Let's Talk About Love* (1997) which were both certified diamond in the US. She also scored a series of international #1 hits, including *The Power of Love* and *I'm Your Angel*. During the 2000s, she built her reputation as a highly successful live performer with *A New Day* (2003–07) which remains the highest-grossing concert residency of all time, as well as the *Taking Chances* World Tour (2008–09), one of the highest-grossing concert tours ever. Dion's music has been influenced by genres ranging from rock and R&B to gospel and classical. She has won 5 Grammy Awards, including Album of the Year. She remains the best-selling Canadian artist and one of the best-selling artists of all time with record sales of 200 million copies worldwide.

Celine Dion's *Courage* World Tour visits western Canada in April 2020. She has only two performances in Vancouver and three other concerts in the Prairie Provinces.

Itinerary

Thursday, April 16:

Meals: L

We drive the Coquihalla to Vancouver and stay two nights at the Blue Horizon Hotel which enjoys an excellent location on Robson Street with lots of shopping and restaurants nearby.

Friday, April 17:

Meals: L

At 11 am, we depart on a Harbour Cruises vessel for a four-hour cruise through Burrard Inlet and **Indian Arm**. Experience this magnificent coastal mountain fjord right in Vancouver's backyard. Old growth forests, pristine waterfalls, various wildlife, and large waterfront homes are some of the high-

lights while sailing through the calm, blue waters of Indian Arm. A delicious buffet lunch is served on board and features fresh BC salmon and chicken. If you have taken the cruise previously and want to do something else today, you can opt out for a discount of \$70. The rest of the afternoon is free time in case you want to visit with friends or relatives. Tonight, we go to Rogers Arena to see **Celine Dion**, starting at 8 pm.

Saturday, April 18:

Meals: L

We depart in late morning and head for home with a lunch stop in Chilliwack.

Seating

Seating is booked in Rogers Arena in Sections 311, 312, 316, 319, and 320.

Important note:

It rarely happens, but performers occasionally get sick, or some mishap causes the cancellation of the concert. This can occur even an hour before the performance begins. We know that this would be extremely disappointing for our customers, but the only refund we would be able to obtain for you would be the actual ticket price for Celine Dion's concert. The hotel, motorcoach, and other tour services are all prepaid and are non-refundable at short notice.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$300 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due February 7, 2020. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Cancellation Policy: Up to January 7, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$150 per person. From January 8 to February 7, the cancellation charge is \$300 per person (your deposit). From February 8 to March 6, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After March 6, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: Policies for Comprehensive and Trip Cancellation & Interruption are available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies must be purchased no later than at final payment.

Activity Level: Light activity including short distances to walk and some steep stairs to and from your Rogers Arena seat. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

E-points: This tour earns 24 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One e-point equals \$1. Redeem your points on tours over 3 days. You can accumulate enough points to earn a free tour (this tour eligible until February 7).
