

JERSEY BOYS

We have been waiting since 2017 for the return of **Jersey Boys** to the west! The show is about The Four Seasons: Frankie Valli, Bob Gaudio, Tommy DeVito and Nick Massi. This is the story of how a group of blue-collar boys from the wrong side of the tracks became one of the biggest American pop music sensations of all time during the 1960s. They wrote their own songs, invented their own sound, and sold 175 million records worldwide - all before they were 30.

The musical **Jersey Boys** opened on Broadway to critical acclaim in 2005 and finally closed in January 2017 after 4,642 performances. The show won 4 Tony Awards including Best Musical in 2006, 2 Drama Desk Awards, the Laurence Olivier Award for Best New Musical, and a Grammy Award. In the past 14 years, productions have toured the USA and seven other countries, and box office records are still being broken. In 2018, the musical began playing on board the cruise ship, Norwegian Bliss. As of 2019, over 25 million people have seen **Jersey Boys**. The show features their hit songs *Sherry*, *Big Girls Don't Cry*, *Rag Doll*, *Oh What a Night*, *My Eyes Adored You*, *Who Loves You*, *Working My Way Back to You*, and *Can't Take My Eyes Off You*.

Itinerary

Tuesday, April 14:

Meals: L

We drive the Coquihalla to the lower mainland, then cross the border at Sumas. Our destination is Lynnwood on the north side of Seattle where we settle into the **Embassy Suites Hotel** for three nights. It features a spacious atrium, a full cooked-to-order breakfast each morning, and a manager's reception with complimentary cocktails and snacks on two evenings.

Wednesday, April 15:

Meals: B

We board a **Duck**, an amphibious bus and boat, for a unique tour around Seattle past the Space Needle, waterfront piers, historic Pioneer Square, the stadiums, and Pike Place Market. Next, the Duck splashes into Lake Union to see Gasworks Park, Dale Chihuly's glass studio, and the *Sleepless in Seattle* houseboats. This afternoon, we go to the **Sky View Observatory**, located on the 73rd floor of Columbia Center. At 274 metres, it offers the tallest public viewing area in the Pacific Northwest. The 360-degree panoramic view includes Mount Rainier, Bellevue, Cascade Range, Mount Baker, Elliott Bay, Olympic Mountains, Space Needle, and the city of Seattle spread out below. A beverage in the lounge is included. Tonight at 7:30 pm, the curtain rises for **Jersey Boys** at the 5th Avenue Theatre.

Thursday, April 16:

Meals: B

There is a shopping opportunity at Alderwood Mall near the hotel. Then we go to the intimate Village Theatre in Issaquah to see the 2 pm matinee of **Hansel & Gretl & Heidi & Günter**. Gretl is now a single mom living in modern day Chicago, still suffering from the trauma of her fairytale childhood. Her 21st century kids are fed up with stuffing their pockets full of pebbles, and dream of the impossible: a normal childhood. But when long-lost Uncle Hansel shows up at their doorstep, they are plunged into an unexpected adventure that brings the family together. This smart and bold new musical is a riotous tumble of past and present that should leave you grinning from ear to ear.

Friday, April 17:

Meals: B

We stop at **Bellis Fair Mall** in Bellingham and the Duty-Free Store at Sumas, then we cross the border and head home.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due February 13, 2020. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$70 discount on first 15 seats and \$35 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after February 13.

Cancellation Policy: Up to January 31, 2020, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From February 1 to February 13, the cancellation charge is \$150 per person (your deposit). From February 14 to March 13, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After March 13, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: Policies for Comprehensive and Trip Cancellation & Interruption are available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies must be purchased no later than at final payment.

Activity Level: Light activity including short distances to walk and some stairs, mainly to and from your theatre seats. There are a few steps to get on and off the Duck. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travelers, to provide ongoing assistance.
