



Amazing Las Vegas

Las Vegas is an internationally renowned resort city known primarily for its gambling, shopping, fine dining, entertainment, and nightlife. It bills itself as "The Entertainment Capital of the World" and is famous for its mega casino-hotels and grandiose shows including seven *Cirque du Soleil* productions and headliner stage shows. Las Vegas traces its roots to 1905, but 1931 was the pivotal year when Nevada legalized casino gambling and construction started on the nearby Hoover Dam. Today, Las Vegas annually ranks as one of the world's most visited tourist destinations.

The MGM Mirage is one of the outstanding hotels on the famous Las Vegas Strip. It offers 14 restaurants, cafés and delis, two gigantic free-form pools with waterfalls, lavish entertainment, spa, shopping centre, and a casino with lots of games. Something for every interest during your leisure time!

There is so much to do in Las Vegas that it is hard to plan a day that satisfies everybody's interests. Some are content to visit casinos — nearby are Caesars Palace, Bellagio, Flamingo, Harrah's, and Treasure Island. Some enjoy the museums, some relax in a spa or pool, and others attend as many shows as possible. This tour offers some activities, but there is lots of free time to do as you wish.

Itinerary

Thursday, October 1:

Meals: D

Flights are on WestJet from Vancouver or Abbotsford to Calgary. Meet the other members of the tour, then continue to Las Vegas, arriving about 4 pm. Our coach is waiting for the short drive to the luxurious **MGM Mirage Hotel**. A welcome dinner is included.

Friday, October 2:

Meals: B

The morning is free time, then we go to the **Mob Museum** which cost over \$40 million to build and opened in 2012. It features the stories of the Mafia and some famous characters of Las Vegas such as Bugsy Siegel, Frank Costello, and Raymond Patriarca. After the guided tour, we meet for a drink in **The Underground Speakeasy** in the museum basement which is a re-creation of a prohibition-era hidden bar where admission was tightly controlled. Next is a guided walking tour of Fremont Street and downtown Las Vegas. Tonight, we go to Caesar's Palace to enjoy a concert by **Rod Stewart**, famed British rock singer and songwriter. Born and raised in London, Stewart is one of the best-selling music artists of all time, having sold over 120 million records worldwide. He has had 9 #1 albums in the UK Albums Chart, 31 hit singles that reached the UK Top 10, and 6 in #1 position. In the USA, Stewart has had 16 Top 10 singles, with 4 reaching #1 on the Billboard Hot 100. As a

solo artist, Stewart was inducted into the US Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1994 and again in 2012, plus the UK Music Hall of Fame in 2006.

Saturday, October 3:

With the benefit of a local guide, we hear stories of Las Vegas as we drive to **Hoover Dam**. Completed in 1935, the dam is 221 metres tall and backs up the Colorado River to form Lake Mead. A tour of the powerhouse is included (subject to change by authorities). The afternoon is leisure time. Tonight, at Bellagio Hotel, we thrill to the **Cirque du Soleil show O**. This awesome show has been running for 22 years in a specially-built theatre and celebrated 10,000 performances in September 2019. O takes place in and above a 1.5-million-gallon pool of water, featuring water acts such as synchronized swimming as well as aerial and ground acts. O has a cast of 85 performers, acrobats, swimmers, and divers.

Sunday, October 4:

This is a free day to do as you wish. A **helicopter** ride for 12-15 minutes over the brilliant lights of the Strip is included tonight (opt out if you wish).

Monday, October 5:

Meals: B

A transfer is provided to the airport. Our WestJet flight leaves at 12:30 pm direct to Vancouver or 1 pm to Calgary, then continue to Abbotsford.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$400 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due June 30, 2020. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$170 discount on first 15 seats and \$85 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after June 30.

Cancellation Policy: Up to May 29, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From May 30 to June 30, the cancellation charge is \$300 per person. From July 1 to July 30, the cancellation charge is 50% of tour fare. From July 31 to August 28, the cancellation charge is 80% of tour fare. After August 28, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and currency exchange and surcharges from the airline and other suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Activity Level: Moderate activity including short distances to walk and some stairs. There are longer walks during the guided tours of Fremont Street and Hoover Dam, and there is a 1 km walk from hotel to Cirque show. This tour has lots of leisure time that you can use to pursue your own interests in Las Vegas. This is not a casino tour — there is no hectic pace of visiting one casino after another, but you can certainly visit casinos at your leisure if you enjoy gambling. If you book your own shows, transportation is not provided. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 2, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and drivers have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be asked to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

e-points: This tour earns 72 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn Experience Points, or e-points. One e-point equals \$1. Redeem your points on select tours or accumulate enough points to earn a free tour! Redemptions offered until June 30.
