ITINERARY

Day 1: Monday, February 22

We travel over the Coquihalla Highway and take a late afternoon ferry from Tsawwassen to Nanaimo.

Meals included: Lunch

Accommodation: Coast Bastion Hotel

Day 2: Tuesday, February 23

We stroll the smooth sands at Rath Trevor Beach and walk among towering firs at **Cathedral Grove** (weather and trail conditions permitting). After lunch in Port Alberni, we drive to the West Coast of Vancouver Island. We stay three nights at the awesome **Wickaninnish Inn** near Tofino. Perched on a rocky point above Chesterman Beach, every room has a splendid ocean view. Maybe you will experience a thrilling winter storm where the spray lashes the windows while you are cuddled comfortably by the fireplace. Savour an elegant dinner in the Salal Room.

Day 3: Wednesday, February 24

Breakfast is included at The Wick each day. Low tide is at 5 pm, so afternoon is the best time for beachcombing and peering into tidal pools. We drive into Tofino for some shopping time, followed by lunch. During the afternoon, we visit **Long Beach**, the best known feature of Pacific Rim National Park. Dinner is on your own so you

can enjoy another tasty experience at the hotel, or the coach provides a transfer into Tofino.

Day 4: Thursday, February 25

In the morning, we drive to **Ucluelet** and admire the spectacle of big waves hitting the point near Amphitrite Lighthouse. The afternoon is free time at the Wickaninnish Inn. Maybe you have an appointment at the Ancient Cedars Spa. Otherwise, enjoy the fitness centre or a stroll. Dinner is included at the hotel's renowned restaurant, The Pointe.

We return to the east coast of Vancouver Island and stay overnight in Chemainus. Take a stroll around the village to admire the colourful murals. If the theatre is still closed due to Covid-19, the company plans to offer a dinner theatre in the Playbill Dining Room.

We ride the ferry from Duke Point to Tsawwassen and travel home via the Coquihalla.

Activity Level 1: Light activity including short distances to walk and some stairs. The walk to Amphytrite Lighthouse is about ½ kilometre, and if you choose not to do this walk, you can enjoy an extended lunch in Ucluelet. The coach cannot carry a scooter. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

TOUR 30 Maximum 30 travellers: This tour is limited to 30, so you feel more comfortable about personal space due to Covid-19.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due December 17, 2020. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$100 discount on first 10 seats and \$50 on next 6 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after December 17, 2020. BC seniors (65 & over) receive \$15 discount extended by BC Ferries, so you must bring your BC Services Card.

Cancellation Policy: Up to November 17, 2020, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From November 18 to December 17, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From December 18, 2020 to January 15, 2021, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After January 15, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore, Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.
