ITINERARY

Day 1: Tuesday, February 15

Heading up island, we stop in Parksville for lunch, then wend our way to the west coast of Vancouver Island. We stay three nights at the awesome **Wickaninnish Inn** near Tofino. Perched on a rocky point above Chesterman Beach, every room has a splendid ocean view. Maybe you will experience a thrilling west coast storm where the spray lashes the windows while you are cuddled comfortably by the fireplace. Tonight, savour an elegant dinner in the Salal Room.

Day 2: Wednesday, February 16

Breakfast is included at The Wick each day. Low tide today is at 6:19 am and high tide is at noon. We drive into Tofino in late morning for some shopping time, followed by lunch. This afternoon, we visit **Long Beach**, the best known feature of Pacific Rim National Park. Take a stroll on the sandy beach and peer into some tidal pools. The best beachcombing occurs during the dropping tide. Back at The Wick, dinner is on your own so you can enjoy another fine dining experience at

the hotel, or the coach provides a transfer into Tofino.

Day 3: Thursday, February 17

In the morning, we drive to **Ucluelet** and enjoy the spectacle of big waves hitting the point near Amphitrite Lighthouse. The afternoon is free time at The Wick (high tide is at 12:55 pm). Dinner is in the hotel's renowned restaurant, The Pointe. **Note:** Please make appointments at Ancient Cedars Spa for Thursday by calling the hotel in advance at 1-250-725-3113.

Activity Level 1: Light activity including short distances to walk and some stairs. The walk to Amphitrite Lighthouse is about ½ kilometre, and if you choose not to do this walk, you can enjoy an extended lunch in Ucluelet. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. If you think you may have difficulty participating in Activity Level 1, Wells Gray Tours recommends that you bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due December 9, 2021. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Cancellation Policy: Up to November 9, 2021, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From November 10 to December 9, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From December 10, 2021 to January 7, 2022, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After January 7, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore, Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes until departure.
