With many travel restrictions being relaxed, I'm happy to announce that Wells Gray Tours is following suit. As of March 1st, all our offices began welcoming in-person visits (with masks). You can still make an appointment if you wish. Almost all our employees are back to work in the offices which I'm sure will quickly return to being the usual buzz of activity.

Fraser has been busy planning tours and, as you can see from our website, he has about 100 tours ready for you to book with lots more in the works. The Operations team are getting used to once again juggling several tours at once as they look ahead to the many departures in the next months. The Marketing staff are excited about spreading the word with so many tours being available.

Our seven tour directors are thrilled to be back on the road, conducting their trips and showing you the world. As announced last fall, two new directors, Elvia and Laura, have joined our ranks and are looking forward to meeting you.

We were able to keep all our office staff working during the pandemic, thanks to the federal wage subsidy and Wells Gray's own robust "Rainy Day Fund", although I think it should be renamed "Rainy Two-Year Fund". In March 2020, we held our traditional annual Staff Retreat where all our 27 employees gathered to plan, debate, learn, and socialize together, little knowing that we were on the cusp of the worst turndown in the travel industry in 70 years.

Fifty years in business is an achievement for any company and 2022 is our half-century milestone. Some of you may remember our 25th Anniversary celebration when we chartered the Rotterdam from Holland America, filled it with 1,100 enthusiastic customers, and sailed away from Vancouver for a special cruise route to Ocean Falls. I still remember being really nervous about signing that cheque!

What to do for the 50th? Our staff were kicking around extravagant ideas starting 2½ years ago and, when Covid reared its ugly head, they put on their well-worn thinking caps again. Not knowing when the pandemic would be safely over, we opted for a celebration close to home. In December, we announced our 50th Anniversary tours would re-create our roots in Wells Gray Park with three departures in May and June. A few seats are still available. I will be personally directing each tour. Our very first tour was on May 20, 1972, so for that occasion 50 years later we have invited our Diamond and some Gold customers to Wells Gray Park for three days.

As if this wasn't enough excitement to look forward to, in January, we revealed our 51st Anniversary event. Why celebrate for only one year when we can do it for two years? On May 14, 2023, we will head to Portugal for a cruise on the Douro River on the *Emerald Radiance*. Wow – did you ever respond with a stampede of bookings!! As of writing this, we have 60 people booked and space for only 30 more. So please don't wait too much longer because somebody else will get your stateroom.

VANCOUVER ISLAND TOE TO TIP



Interior & Lower Mainland: May 14, 2022 – 9 days
Vancouver Island: May 15, 2022 – 8 days

Vancouver Island is the 11th largest island in Canada, stretching 460 km from the Strait of Juan de Fuca to Queen Charlotte Sound. Named for Captain George Vancouver, who explored B.C.'s coast in 1792, the island has great diversity ranging from the capital city of Victoria to remote mountain peaks in Strathcona Park, and from the wild wind-lashed beaches of the west coast to the sandy expanse of Rath Trevor Beach. Only a handful of people have travelled from toe to tip and experienced both ends of Vancouver Island: Race Rocks off Victoria and Cape Sutil north of Port Hardy. There are no roads to either place, so we have chartered vessels for excursions to get you there. A third boat excursion is on *MV Frances Barkley* on its scheduled sailing to the village of Bamfield in Barkley Sound. In between the toe and tip, there is so much to see and do on the Island that a month would not be long enough, but we have picked some well-known highlights and secret gems for this nine-day tour. Come and explore Vancouver Island!

B.C. FJORDS DEPARTURE #2

Interior: July 2, 2022 – 7 days

Some of the most thrilling sights along the B.C. coast cannot be reached by road, and the only access is by boat. This tour includes four boat excursions into these remote places. Knight Inlet is the longest fjord on our coastline, extending 113 km deep into the Coast Mountains. Nakwakto Rapids are the fastest tidal rapids in the world, according to Guinness, and during our visit the waters pouring out of Seymour Inlet and Belize Inlet will attain the incredible speed of 11.6 knots. A third boat trip departs Campbell River, weaves among the Northern Gulf Islands, and cruises through the magical beauty of Desolation Sound to Lund on the Sunshine Coast. A fourth cruise explores amazing Princess Louisa Fjord where sheer cliffs rise a thousand metres out of the water and thundering Chatterbox Falls dominates its upper end. This tour sold out so quickly, we added a second departure.

BARKERVILLE & SUN PEAKS

Interior: July 18, 2022 – 5 days

The history of the Cariboo gold rush in Barkerville meets relaxation in the alpine meadows of Sun Peaks. First we visit historic Barkerville where you can listen to Judge Begbie, watch the gold cleanup at the Cornish waterwheel, ride in a stagecoach, do some goldpanning, eat at Wake-Up Jake's Café, and enjoy a lively show at Theatre Royal. Then it's off to Sun Peaks, one of BC's best four-season resorts, with summer weather welcoming outdoor adventurers and holiday-seekers alike. Relax at the Sun Peaks Grand Hotel, the finest of many in the village and ideally located in the midst of all the shops and restaurants of this booming resort town. Ride the chairlift high onto Tod Mountain and admire the display of colourful wild flowers.

Enjoy summer with this ideal combination of the historic Gold Rush Trail and relaxation at a waterfront First Nations lodge. Quaaout Lodge enjoys a beautiful setting on the shore of Little Shuswap Lake. Opened in 1992 by the Skwax First Nation, it was named "Quaaout" which means "when the sun's rays first hit the water". Several cultural experiences are included during our stay including a smudge ceremony and Kekuli storytelling. Then it's off to Barkerville, which turns 161 years old in 2022. The restored town is still bringing joy to visitors as they relive the days of the old west. Add to this the BC Wildlife Park, Hell's Gate Airtram, and Harrison Hot Springs, and you have a wonderful summer getaway close to home.

Explore the stunning North Coast by land and sea! The 500-kilometre journey from Port Hardy to Prince Rupert aboard BC Ferries' *Northern Expedition* takes 15 hours, all in daylight to permit great viewing of the rugged coastline and abundant wildlife. In Prince Rupert, we thrill to a 7-hour catamaran excursion to the Khutzeymateen Grizzly Sanctuary and also tour the restored North Pacific Cannery. Then we board VIA Rail's *Skeena Train* for a spectacular all-day journey east to Prince George in deluxe 'Touring Class' with seating in the dome car. We drive south through the Cariboo with a visit to the historic gold rush town of Barkerville. This is a wonderful British Columbia circle tour that has been so popular we've added a second departure.

HAIDA GWAI



Interior: July 20, July 30 & Aug 9, 2022 – 7 days
Vancouver Island: July 25 & Aug 9, 2022 – 7 days

Haida Gwaii is an archipelago of more than 150 islands off the northwest coast of BC known for vibrant Haida culture, rugged coast-lines, a stunning array of marine life, and giant old-growth cedars. One of the outstanding experiences on this tour is a flight to Ninistints at the south end of Moresby Island. Known by the Haida as SGang Gwaay, it is the best preserved of the abandoned Haida villages and was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1981. Other highlights include: The Haida Heritage Centre at Kaay'llnagaay, a Zodiac tour around Louise Island stopping at Skedans Village, Tow Hill with its Blowhole, Balance Rock, Port Clements Museum, a studio and artisan tour, and a fabulous traditional Haida Feast.

Bella Coola is an isolated community on the central BC coast, surrounded by splendid mountain scenery. The ferry and the highway offer an awesome circle route to Bella Coola. The 10-hour daylight voyage along the rugged BC coast is an amazing experience of seascapes and wildlife. Too many people take only a day to drive the 450 km highway whereas this tour devotes three days to the trip, allowing time for many stops and the thrill of "The Hill". A highlight is the flight into Tweedsmuir Park to see Hunlen Falls, Canada's highest waterfall, the vast Monarch Icefields, and the colourful Rainbow Range.




