

ITINERARY

Day 1: Monday, March 6

We take an afternoon ferry from Tsawwassen to Nanaimo.

Accommodation: Coast Bastion Hotel

Day 2: Tuesday, March 7

We stroll the smooth sands at Rath Trevor Beach and walk among towering firs at **Cathedral Grove** (if conditions permit). After lunch in Port Alberni, we drive to the West Coast of Vancouver Island. We stay three nights at the awesome **Wickaninnish Inn** near Tofino. Perched on a rocky point above Chesterman Beach, every room has a splendid ocean view. Maybe you will experience a thrilling storm where the spray lashes the windows while you are cuddled comfortably by the fireplace. Dinner is included at the hotel's renowned restaurant, The Pointe, with a limited choice menu.

Day 3: Wednesday, March 8

Breakfast is included at The Wick each day. Low tides today are at 7:08 am and 7:22 pm, and high tide is at 1:10 pm. We drive into Tofino in late morning for some shopping and lunch time. This afternoon, we visit **Long Beach**, the best known feature of Pacific Rim National Park. Take a stroll on the sandy beach and peer into some tidal pools. The best beachcombing occurs during the dropping tide. Dinner is on your own so you can enjoy another tasty experience at the hotel, or the coach provides a transfer into Tofino.

Day 4: Thursday, March 9

Low tides are at 7:43 am and 7:49 pm, and high tide is at 1:47 pm. In the morning, we drive to **Ucluelet** and admire the spectacle of big waves hitting the point near Amphitrite Lighthouse. The afternoon is free time at the Wickaninnish Inn. Maybe you have an appointment at the Ancient Cedars Spa. Otherwise, enjoy the fitness centre or a stroll on the beach. Dinner is served in The Pointe.

Day 5: Friday, March 10

We return to the east coast of Vancouver Island with a stop for lunch in Parksville. A sumptuous dinner is served at **Chemainus Theatre**, followed by the evening show. The spring 2023 season will be announced in the fall of 2022.

Day 6: Saturday, March 11

We ride the ferry from Duke Point to Tsawwassen and travel home.

Activity Level 1: Light activity including short distances to walk and some stairs. The amount of walking at Long Beach is up to you. The walk to Amphitrite Lighthouse is about 500 metres. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. If Activity Level 1 could be challenging, you are urged to bring a companion to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$300 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due January 4, 2023. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined.

Discounts: BC seniors (65 & over) receive \$16 discount extended by BC Ferries, so you must bring your BC Services Card.

Cancellation Policy: Up to December 2, 2022, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From December 3, 2022 to January 4, 2023, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person. From January 5 to February 3, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After February 3, there is no refund.

Itinerary and Fare Changes: As the world emerges from the pandemic, many of our suppliers such as hotels, restaurants, attractions, and transportation providers are struggling with shortage of staff, inflated costs, and supply line challenges. Sometimes we are notified about changes to the itinerary prior to departure and sometimes during the tour. We do our best to substitute a similar service if something cancels, but occasionally the only alternative is to provide a refund for the missed activity. Please note that if we are forced to cancel a component of a tour due to an issue beyond our control, the current penalties still apply if you choose to cancel the entire tour. Fuel surcharges and changes to taxes or other tour costs can occur at any time, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up to departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. Restaurants in remote areas may not be able to satisfy all food allergies. As restaurants recover from two years of pandemic restrictions, many facing severe labour shortages, we have been informed that food allergies should be honoured, but it is impossible to handle everybody's requests for food preferences. (An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not.) For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Home pickups are available within Greater Vancouver for an additional charge of \$75 per person round trip. Transfer is to and from the coach route along Highways #1 and #17 to Tsawwassen. Please request no later than at final payment.
