SKAGIT TULIP FESTIVAL

April 17, 2023 – 4 Days

Staying 3 nights at Tulalip Resort & Casino

The Skagit Valley explodes in an abundance of colour when the tulips blossom. Although Mother Nature ultimately decides the dates, the second to third week of the month tends to be good timing for this showy display. Whether early or late, there are usually dainty yellow daffodils first, followed by a rainbow of tulips, then the irises and lilies after that. We attend the Tulip Festival on a weekday to avoid the crowds that come here on weekends from Seattle. This tour visits La Conner, a delightful waterfront town of heritage buildings and interesting shopping. A cruise from La Conner through dramatic Deception Pass with a cracked crab dinner is a highlight on April 19. This tour stays at the luxurious Tulalip Resort and Casino, located about 30 minutes drive from the focal area of the Tulip Festival. Come and admire the blossoms and colours of the Skagit Valley.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Monday, April 17

We meet the Wells Gray travellers from Victoria and cross the border at Blaine. We stay three nights at luxurious **Tulalip Resort and Casino** which features guest rooms with styling that pays homage to the rich history and culture of the Tulalip Tribes. It has eight restaurants and lounges, heated indoor swimming pool, hot tub, fitness centre, sauna, and spa treatments. A \$20 casino voucher is provided for your enjoyment in the casino.

Day 2: Tuesday, April 18

The morning is leisure time. This afternoon, we participate in some events of the annual **Skagit Valley Tulip Festival** when millions of tulips bloom. A local guide takes us through this floral extravaganza, taking advantage of a midweek day when the roads and gardens are far less crowded. Stops include the show gardens at Tulip Town and Roozengaarde.

Day 3: Wednesday, April 19

The morning is free time at the hotel and you may want to shop at the adjacent **Seattle Premium Outlets** where there are over 130 stores. Later, we drive to the quaint village of **La Conner** where there is time to stroll the waterfront streets and browse the shops. At 4 pm, we board a vessel for a 2½-hour cruise under La Conner's Rainbow Bridge, along narrow Swinomish Channel, and through Saratoga Passage to **Deception Pass**. A lofty bridge connects Fidalgo Island with Whidbey Island using two spans totalling 500 metres long, and we sail through the turbulent tidal waters underneath. The bridge rises 55 metres above the water and was completed in 1935. A tasty cracked crab feast is included on the boat.

Day 4: Thursday, April 20

Departing in mid-morning, we go to **Bellis Fair Mall** in Bellingham for lunch and shopping time. We stop at the Duty Free store and cross the border at Blaine.

TOUR NOTES

 **Activity Level 1:** Light activity including short distances to walk and some stairs. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. If Activity Level 1 could be challenging, you must bring a companion who is able to assist you. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some tour days.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due February 28, 2023. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking, cheque, Visa or Mastercard.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$60 discount on first 15 seats and \$30 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after February 28, 2023.

Cancellation Policy: Up to January 30, 2023, the cancellation charge is \$50 per person. From January 31 to February 28, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From March 1 to March 17, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After March 17, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore, Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes until departure.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.

Home pickups are available within Greater Vancouver for an additional charge of \$75 per person round trip. Transfer is to and from the coach route along Highways #17 and #99 from/to Tsawwassen. Please request no later than at final payment.
