ITINERARY

Day 1: Tuesday, November 14

Heading up island, we stop in Parksville for lunch, then wend our way to the west coast of Vancouver Island. We stay three nights at the awesome **Wickaninnish Inn** near Tofino. Perched on a rocky point above Chesterman Beach, every room has a splendid ocean view. Maybe you will experience a thrilling west coast storm where the spray lashes the windows while you are cuddled comfortably by the fireplace. Dinner is in the hotel's renowned restaurant, The Pointe.

Day 2: Wednesday, November 15

Breakfast is included at The Wick each day. Low tide today is at 7:05 am and high tide is at 1:02 pm. The best beachcombing occurs during the dropping tide. We drive into Tofino in late morning with time for shopping and lunch. This afternoon, we visit **Long Beach**, the best known feature of Pacific Rim National Park. Take a stroll on the sandy beach and peer into some tidal pools. Back at The Wick, dinner is on your own so you

can enjoy another fine dining experience at the hotel, or the coach provides a transfer into Tofino.

Day 3: Thursday, November 16

Low tide today is at 7:47 am and high tide is at 1:42 pm. In the morning, we drive to **Ucluelet** and enjoy the spectacle of big waves hitting the point near Amphitrite Lighthouse. The afternoon is free time at The Wick, so be sure to take a walk on **Chesterman Beach** during the dropping tide. Maybe you have booked an appointment at the Ancient Cedars Spa. Dinner is served in The Pointe.

Day 4: Friday, November 17

We return to the east coast of Vancouver Island with a stop for lunch in Port Alberni.

- **Duncan, Nanaimo & Parksville area clients:** The coach from Victoria picks you up during the morning of November 14 and drops you off in mid-afternoon November 17.
- **Comox, Campbell River & area clients:** We are providing a complimentary transfer to Parksville to join the group at lunch on November 14, and transfer home from Parksville on November 17.



Activity Level 1: Light activity including short distances to walk and some stairs. The walk to Amphitrite Lighthouse is about ½ kilometre and, if you choose not to do this walk, you can enjoy an extended lunch in Ucluelet. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. **Everybody** participating in this tour is expected to be capable of handling Activity Level 1. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due September 7, 2023. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (1.5% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Cancellation Policy: Up to August 7, 2023, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$100 per person. From August 8 to September 7, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From September 8 to October 6, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare. After October 6, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore, Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes until departure.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Please contact us for details.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. This tour goes to a remote destination where restaurants may not be able to satisfy all food allergies. Please do not tell us about your food preferences, as restaurants ignore these requests. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.
