ITINERARY

Day 1: Tuesday, November 7

We arrive in mid-afternoon at **Harrison Hot Springs Resort** and accommodation is booked in the East Tower. All guestrooms feature floor-to-ceiling windows with balconies, refrigerators, free wi-fi, and complimentary bathrobes for use during your stay. Dinner is in the Lakeside Café.

Take a walk along the lake shore trails. Of course, the hot springs are an enticing and soothing pastime. After lunch, we go to **Creekside Cheese & Creamery** to tour the barns, meet the animals, and get an overview of the basics of cheesemaking with cheese and milk samples.

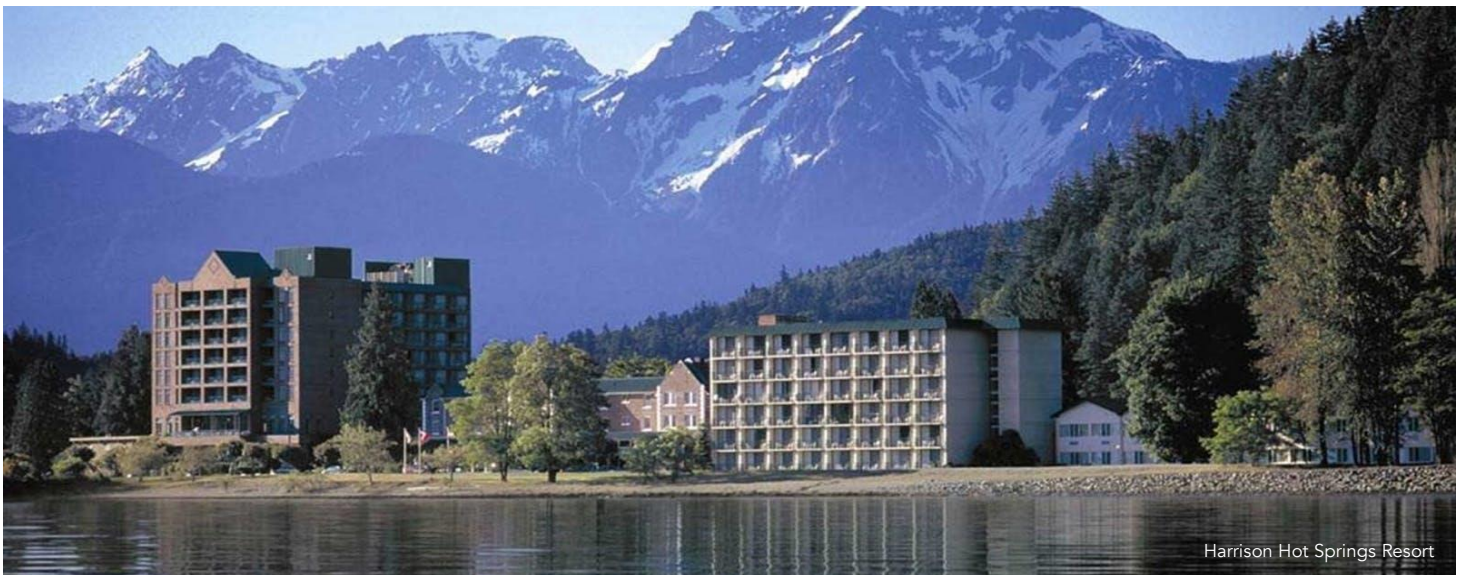

Activity Level 1: Light activity with short walks and some stairs. There is a 5 minute walk to the boat dock, plus short walks at Kilby Site and Creekside Creamery. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. **Everybody** participating in this tour is expected to be capable of handling Activity Level 1. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due September 20, 2023. By paying the deposit, you agree to the Terms & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (1.5% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Early Booking Bonus: Early bookers receive \$60 discount on first 15 seats and \$30 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after September 20, 2023.

Cancellation Policy: Up to August 21, 2023, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$50 per person. From August 22 to September 20, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From September 21 to October 6, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After October 6, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes until departure.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. Please do not tell us about your food preferences, as restaurants ignore these requests. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard.
