# typerience

It's nearly the end of summer which I usually regret because it means the hiking season is almost over. This year, the cooler and rainier days of fall will be so welcome in helping to extinguish the terrible wildfires and dissipate the lingering smoke in our valleys.

In my ramble for the June newsletter, I told you about the importance of giving back for Wells Gray Tours and our donation to West Coast Environmental Law. That donation will be used to support two conservation projects in the Kamloops area, and next year the donation will be made to an environmental organization in the Kelowna area.

In addition, each of our five offices has a budget to support a local charity and the decision about the recipient is made by the local manager. So far this year, Wells Gray Tours has donated to the Kamloops Food Bank - Starfish Backpacks Program, Project Literacy Central Okanagan Society, Kelowna Professional Firefighters Association – Central Okanagan Fire Relief, Allan Brooks Nature Centre in Vernon, Critteraid in Summerland, Animal Lifeline Emergency Response Team Society, CFAX Santas Anonymous in Victoria, and the Greater Victoria Green Team.

Anne and I have personally funded the summer 2023 naturalist program in Wells Gray Park, the trail crew which spent four months repairing and maintaining over 100 km of park trails, and the new stairway at Moul Falls, all accomplished through donations to the BC Parks Foundation.

A little bit of every tour you buy is donated to a variety of well-deserving charities!

Electric vehicles are frequently in the media and maybe some of you already have one. I hope you love it! Anne and I bought our first EV, a Nissan Leaf, in 2012 and it was one of the first in Kamloops. We replaced it in 2018 since the range had doubled and the new Leaf was more practical for longer trips. In April, I bought a Lightning, the Ford electric pickup truck with a range of 450 km, so we have abandoned gasoline powered vehicles and are very happy with the decision.

We encourage our employees to go electric and Wells Gray offers a \$5,000 grant to help offset the higher cost of buying. Stephanie and Danny in the Kamloops office drive EVs and are very pleased with their choices.

The Wells Gray fall travel shows are coming up. There are lots of exciting new tours already out for sale or soon to be announced. Stephanie attended Rendezvous Canada in May and will be at Atlantic Canada Showcase in September, and four staff will be gathering travel ideas at the National Tour Association convention in November. All these meetings are valuable for hearing presentations about new destinations, hotels, and attractions, and many of them get incorporated into our tours in the following years. Some of our unique new trips include Northern Lights in Iceland, April's Solar Eclipse Cruise, New Zealand & Australia Cruise, Mississippi River Cruise, Savannah & Charleston, Blue Jays games in San Diego, Western Newfoundland & Labrador, and Suez Canal Cruise. Christmas is less than four months away and our four departures to various places are already selling well. Kerrie and Miranda have done a fabulous job of redesigning our brochures and I hope you like the new look.

The 7th President's Cruise was announced two weeks ago and right away sold 28 spaces. Anne and I will host this tour including several receptions on the ship. We cruise from Tromsø in northern Norway to the islands of Spitsbergen way up at the 80th latitude, then on to Iceland. It leaves on June 4, 2024 for 21 days. Even after a lifetime of travel, I still have some places on my bucket list and Spitsbergen is one of them. Please come and join us!

# Theatre & Shows

#### CIRQUE DU SOLEIL IN VANCOUVER



#### BC Interior & Vancouver Island: November 18, 2023 – 3 days

Every few years, Cirque du Soleil presents one of its astounding shows in Vancouver. In 2022, the show was Alegría. Others were Luzia in 2019, Kurios in 2017, and Totem in 2014. The venue is always the Grand Chapiteau, a gigantic circus tent usually erected near Pacific Blvd. Wells Gray has offered tours to see all these shows. Koozå premiered in Montréal in 2007 and has since played in over 56 cities in 18 countries on 4 continents. The show's 3,000th performance was in Montevideo, Uruguay in 2016. Over 7.5 million people have seen Koozå. It has been to Vancouver only once before, in 2015. One of the most daring acts is the Wheel of Death, a 1,600-pound doublebarrel axle that rotates at high speed while two artists perform incredible acrobatics. This tour stays 2 nights at the Blue Horizon Hotel on Robson Street in downtown Vancouver. Totality occurs only in a narrow path across Earth's surface, with a partial eclipse visible from a band on either side. Solar eclipses are rare events. This eclipse will be the first total solar eclipse to be visible in Canada since February 26, 1979, and the first in Mexico since July 11, 1991. It will be the only total solar eclipse in the 21st century where totality can be experienced in Mexico, the United States, and Canada. It will also be the last total solar eclipse visible in the contiguous USA until August 12, 2045. For ideal viewing of the solar eclipse, the Zaandam will position off Mazatlan on April 8 from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm.




