Experience ROLAND'S RAMBLE

It was on a 200-passenger ship sailing from Nome, Alaska, to Vancouver with stops in the Pribilof Islands, Aleutian Islands, and Hubbard Glacier. We hope to offer Seabourn in the coming years. In October, I directed the last of four farewell tours to Tsa-Kwa-Luten Lodge on Quadra Island, now being converted to a First Nations addiction treatment

In November, Fraser, Terri, and Joan travelled with me to Shreveport, Louisiana, to attend the National Tour Association convention. Fraser has been on the Board of Directors for five years and was elected Chair for 2024, a very prestigious position leading a worldwide organization of tour operators and suppliers. I was truly honoured to be given the Bob Everidge Lifetime Achievement Award by NTA and spoke for three minutes (strictly limited) about Wells Gray Tours' growth from day tours in Wells Gray Park in 1972 to today's trips to all seven continents. Thank you to all of you who read or heard about this award in the local media and have sent me messages of congratulations.

There are two President's Cruises out for sale right now. Anne, Fraser and I hope you can join us for one or both. In June 2024, we are cruising on Norwegian Star from Tromsø, Norway, to Reykjavík via the remote islands of Spitsbergen. Only seven spaces are left. In January 2025, we are on the Emerald Harmony cruising the storied Mekong River in Cambodia and Vietnam. We hope to fill the entire ship and it's over half full already. As an added incentive to book early, everybody signed up will be entered in a draw on December 21 and the winner can choose an upgrade to the Grand Balcony Suite on the ship or a flight in business class to and from Vietnam. On both cruises, we will be hosting several receptions and social events.

Our 60th Mystery Tour was announced last week and it's already over half full. You need a passport, we are flying somewhere, and there are seven clues which may let you figure out where we are going. I have directed most of the Mystery Tours since 1985, but Pat will handle this one because I'm planning to go to St. John's for the NTA Spring convention and cheer on Fraser who will be front and centre. The tour leaves May 15 for 11 days. We will only have one Mystery Tour in 2024 because it is getting harder to create unique ideas.

After lots of discussion, I'm pleased to announce that Wells Gray Tours is adjusting Activity Levels. There are now four instead of three with the higher numbers being more active. In a nutshell, the former Level 3 is now Level 4, and the former Level 2 is being split with the more active ones becoming Level 3. We hope this helps you decide more easily which activity level is suited to your abilities. Another exciting announcement is that the maximum capacity of our tours will be 40 people instead of 46 on tours longer than 4 days.

Anne and I are excited about our daughter Heather arriving for Christmas tomorrow. She is saying goodbye to Denmark after 2½ years working in dairy research at the University of Aarhus and completing her post-doctoral. In January, she starts a new position as Assistant Professor at Purdue University in Indiana, finally living on the same continent and a much shorter flight to come and visit.

NEW TOUR ACTIVITY LEVELS

We have moved to a new four scale activity level rating system

Activity Level 1

Light activity: You are a sedentary traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods and walk at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. Please be aware that on tours with flights and cruises you will be required to handle your own luggage and walk longer distances in airports and cruise terminals.

You may bring a walker or cane if needed. The coaches cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Activity Level 3

High activity: You are an active traveller who wants to explore wherever you go. You don't mind

a mix of full days, early morning starts, and some late nights. You can walk longer distances, up to 4 km without difficulty which may be over uneven ground, beaches/shorelines, or at higher elevations; climb in and out of zodiacs or small boats without any assistance; walk on docks which may have steep ramps at low tide; and stand for prolonged periods. You can climb three flights of stairs easily and unassisted, can handle altitudes up to 9,000 ft (2800 metres) with no health issue, and can handle your own luggage in airports, cruise terminals, or at hotels where luggage handling may not be available.

This tour is not appropriate for people with canes, walkers, wheelchairs, or other mobility assistance devices. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Please note: Prior to accepting your booking, you will be required to sign a declaration that you are capable of travelling on an Activity Level 3 tour.

Activity Level 2

Moderate activity: As a traveller you like a variety of activities and walking up to 2 km with breaks such as a guided walking tour is very doable for you without assistance. You can stand for prolonged periods, negotiate a variety of terrain from cobblestone streets to moderate hills comfortably, and can climb two flights of stairs without assistance. Please be aware that on tours with flights and cruises you will be required to handle your own luggage and walk longer distances in airports and cruise terminals. In addition, you may need to handle your own luggage at hotels where luggage handling is not available.

You may bring a cane if needed. The coaches cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Activity Level 4

Rigorous activity +: You want adventure and are ready to try anything. You lead an active life at

home, walking, biking, hiking or sking and 10,000 steps or more a day is normal for you. You can handle walking up to 3 hours or 8 km, traversing uneven terrain, steep slopes, standing for prolonged periods of time, and you can manage your own luggage. You don't mind a mix of full days; early morning starts and some late nights. You can handle altitudes of 13,000 ft (400 metres) or higher with no health issues.

This tour is not appropriate for people with canes, walkers, wheelchairs, or other mobility assistance devices. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Please note: Prior to accepting your booking, you will be required to sign a declaration that you are capable of travelling on an Activity Level 4 tour.



SLOW COOKER CRANBERRY APPLE CIDER from Lynne

This recipe Lynne found on Pinterest is perfect for warming up after a ski or snowmobile day.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 liter apple juice pure unsweetened
- 2 cups orange juice pure unsweetened
- 1 liter cranberry juice unsweetened
- 1/4-1/2 cup sugar (stevia, honey or other sweetener) (to taste)
- 3 cinnamon sticks whole
- 1/8 teaspoon ground cloves

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Add all ingredients to a 4 quart or larger slow cooker. Stir.

Holiday Recip

- 2. Cook at least 3-4 hours on low or until hot. Keep warm as long as needed on the low or warm setting.
- *Leftovers refrigerate wonderfully and reheats just fine!

PAVLOVA (serves 6-8) from the Neaves

Roland makes this New Zealand dessert every year for Christmas dinner.

INGREDIENTS

- 4 egg whites
- 1 heaped cup of white sugar
- 1 heaped teaspoon of cornstarch pinch salt
- 1 tsp. vinegar
- 1 tsp. vanilla

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F.
- 2. Separate and beat egg whites stiff in a small bowl. With mixer on low speed beat in half the sugar. Then beat on high for 5 minutes. Turn mixer to low again and beat in rest of sugar, teaspoon by teaspoon. On low speed, stir in salt, cornstarch, vinegar and vanilla.
- 3. Wet cookie sheet and cover with parchment paper. Put meringue on paper, shaping it into a 9 inch circle with slightly raised edges.
- 4. Put pavlova in heated to 350°F oven and turn immediately to 250°F. Bake 1 hr. Turn to 150°F and bake 1/2 hr. Turn oven off and let cool completely in the oven.
- 5. If you are making ahead, cover lightly with waxed paper, and refrigerate.
- 6. Serve covered with slices of fresh fruit, like kiwi, strawberries, and blueberries. Cover the fruit with sweetened whipped cream.

Vancouver Island is the 11th largest island in Canada, stretching 460 km from the Strait of Juan de Fuca to Queen Charlotte Sound. Named for Captain George Vancouver who explored B.C.'s coast in 1792, the island has great diversity ranging from the capital city of Victoria to remote mountain peaks in Strathcona Park, and from the wild wind-lashed beaches of the west coast to the sandy expanse of Rathtrevor Beach. Only a handful of people have travelled from toe to tip and experienced both ends of Vancouver Island: Race Rocks off Victoria and Cape Sutil (not Cape Scott) north of Port Hardy. There are no roads to either place, so we have chartered vessels to get you there. Other boat excursions are on MV Frances Barkley on its scheduled sailing to Bamfield, and a cruise that weaves among the northern Gulf Islands. In between the toe and tip, there is so much to see and do on the Island that a month would not be long enough. We have picked some highlights for this 10-day tour that are wellknown and less-known. 




