typerience **ROLAND'S RAMBLE**

January and February have flown by. Some of our winter tours have already returned. Anne and I escaped from winter for 11 days on board an Emerald Cruises yacht in the Caribbean. The Sakara carries only 100 people, so it is a very small vessel compared to the mammoth ships that are usually cruising in the Caribbean. We boarded in San Juan, Puerto Rico, and sailed to some of the lesser-known islands such as Culebra, Viegues, and Tortola. Next January, we will be offering our first cruise on the Sakara. Prepare to be pampered with wonderful meals, beautiful balcony staterooms, open bar, and an intimate setting.

Don't miss our Spring Travel Shows when some new tours will be announced. Our very busy Kerrie has organized 14 shows around British Columbia, so I hope that one of them is close to you. I'm planning to attend a few of them and look forward to mingling with you.

I'm actually home for a few months. I will be directing the Palm Springs & San Diego to Vancouver cruise April 23 to May 3. Then I'm off to St. John's, NL, for the spring National Tour Association convention, along with four staff and Fraser who is the NTA chair for 2024. In June, I will be checking off one of my bucket list items which is Spitsbergen, way up in the Arctic north of Norway. This is the annual President's Cruise and is on the Norwegian Star. The 2025 President's Cruise, on the Mekong River in January, was announced last November and is ¾ full already, so be sure to book soon. Have you ever wanted to cruise in a suite? Book by April 10 to be entered in a draw for an upgrade to the fancy Grand Balcony Suite. Our ship is the Emerald Harmony, carrying about 70 passengers, so this is truly an intimate gathering of Wells Gray travellers. Anne and I look forward to meeting you on one of these trips.

Safety during a holiday is top of mind for many travellers and Wells Gray planners spend a lot of time monitoring situations which occasionally arise at our destinations. In all countries outside of Canada and USA, we utilize the services of receptive operators. These are people who actually live there and can closely watch for any

developing issues. Unfortunately, some media sensationalize incidents, even though they may be easy for tourists to avoid. I remember some widely reported rioting in Cairo 10 years ago, but our local colleague responded to our worried calls to say that it was confined to a single block far away from the tourist attractions. Sometimes we do cancel tours when our assessment is that it is unsafe to go there, based on our sources at that destination. For instance, we cancelled an April 2023 tour to Machu Picchu because there were uprisings in Cusco and near Lake Titicaca. A few weeks ago, we cancelled a November 2024 cruise through the Suez Canal because the Red Sea has experienced attacks on freighters. Our November 2023 tour to Egypt and Jordan was supposed to finish with two days in Israel, so we shortened the tour and flew home from Amman instead of Tel Aviv. Our Egyptian advisor was quite correct when she said there was absolutely nothing of concern happening in Egypt and Jordan, but many other tourists stayed away, presumably due to misleading information, and our group enjoyed uncrowded attractions for three weeks. Rest assured that Wells Gray Tours will never knowingly take you to an unsafe destination.

NEW TOUR ACTIVITY LEVELS

We have moved to a new four scale activity level rating system

Activity Level 1

Light activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods and walk at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. Please be aware that on tours with flights and cruises you will be required to handle your own luggage and walk longer distances in airports and cruise terminals.

You may bring a walker or cane if needed. The coaches cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Activity Level 3

High activity: You are an active traveller who wants to explore wherever you go. You don't mind

a mix of full days, early morning starts, and some late nights. You can walk longer distances, up to 4 km without difficulty which may be over uneven ground, beaches/shorelines, or at higher elevations; climb in and out of zodiacs or small boats without any assistance; walk on docks which may have steep ramps at low tide; and stand for prolonged periods. You can climb three flights of stairs easily and unassisted, can handle altitudes up to 9,000 ft (2800 metres) with no health issues, and can handle your own luggage in airports, cruise terminals, or at hotels where luggage handling may not be available.

This tour is not appropriate for people with canes, walkers, wheelchairs, or other mobility assistance devices. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Please note: Prior to accepting your booking, you will be required to sign a declaration that you are capable of travelling on an Activity Level 3 tour.

Activity Level 2

Moderate activity: As a traveller you like a variety of activities and walking up to 2 km with breaks such as a guided walking tour is very doable for you without assistance. You can stand for prolonged periods, negotiate a variety of terrain from cobblestone streets to moderate hills comfortably, and can climb two flights of stairs without assistance. Please be aware that on tours with flights and cruises you will be required to handle your own luggage and walk longer distances in airports and cruise terminals. In addition, you may need to handle your own luggage at hotels where luggage handling is not available.

You may bring a cane if needed. The coaches cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Activity Level 4

Rigorous activity +: You want adventure and are ready to try anything. You lead an active life at home, walking, biking, hiking or ski-

ing and 10,000 steps or more a day is normal for you. You can handle walking up to 3 hours or 8 km, traversing uneven terrain, steep slopes, standing for prolonged periods of time, and you can manage your own luggage. You don't mind a mix of full days; early morning starts and some late nights. You can handle altitudes of 13,000 ft (4000 metres) or higher with no health issues.

This tour is not appropriate for people with canes, walkers, wheelchairs, or other mobility assistance devices. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

Please note: Prior to accepting your booking, you will be required to sign a declaration that you are capable of travelling on an Activity Level 4 tour.





HAIDA GWAII

Haida Gwaii is an archipelago of more than 150 islands located off the northwest coast of British Columbia Formerly called the Queen Charlotte Islands until 2010, Haida Gwaii is the westernmost point of Canada and is known for its vibrant Haida culture, rugged coast-lines, majestic mountains, stunning array of marine life, and giant old-growth cedars. One of the outstanding experiences is a Zodiac tour around Louise Island stopping at the abandoned Haida village of Skedans. 

The only road access is Highway #20 from Williams Lake, a scenic drive across the Chilcotin and through the Coast Mountains. TYAX RESORT

Escape to Tyax Lodge, a peaceful retreat on the shore of Tyaughton Lake with a fine view of snowy peaks. The lodge is one of the largest log buildings in western Canada and you are sure to admire its fine craftsmanship, especially the cathedral lobby with a soaring stone chimney. We stay here for all three nights of the tour. Nearby is Bralorne, once one of British Columbia's greatest gold mines. The fabulous Pioneer Mine produced \$140 million of gold between 1914 and 1960. A local historian accompanies us to explain the fascinating story of Bralorne, Bradian, Gold Bridge, the Haylmore Historic Site, and Gun Lake. Another highlight of this valley is the fall foliage which usually peaks in early October.

Winnipeg's premier event, Folklorama, still the largest and longest running multicultural festival of its kind in the world, began modestly in 1970. Folklorama was conceived as a one-time event to celebrate Manitoba's Centennial. It was so successful that it has returned every year since. The event's 40 pavilions receive over 425,000 visits in the two week period, plus 15,000 visitors to the Kick-Off event held the night before pavilions open. In 1970, the festival was only 7 days long with 21 pavilions participating. Since then the festival has grown to two full weeks with 20 pavilions open each week. From traditional home-cooked meals to electrifying nightly performances by local, national and international entertainers, Folklorama creates a feast for the senses. During each of our 3 evenings at Folklorama, we experience 3 different pavilions with unique food, drink, and entertainment offerings. 


