There are so many attractions and experiences in the Revelstoke area, but because it is so close to the Okanagan and Kamloops, many travellers drive right through to Rogers Pass. This short summer tour spends 3 nights at the Sutton Place Hotel, located at Revelstoke Mountain Resort on Mount Mackenzie. On the way there, we stop at Three Valley Gap to see the ghost town, antique auto museum, railway roundhouse, and gardens. In the Revelstoke area, we ride the gondola up Mount Mackenzie to admire a fabulous view and hopefully blooming alpine meadows. The Revelstoke Railway Museum, Giant Cedars, and Canyon Hot Springs are other attractions in the area. The return drive goes along the Arrow Lakes via two ferries, then over Monashee Pass. Come and enjoy some mountain scenery close to home!

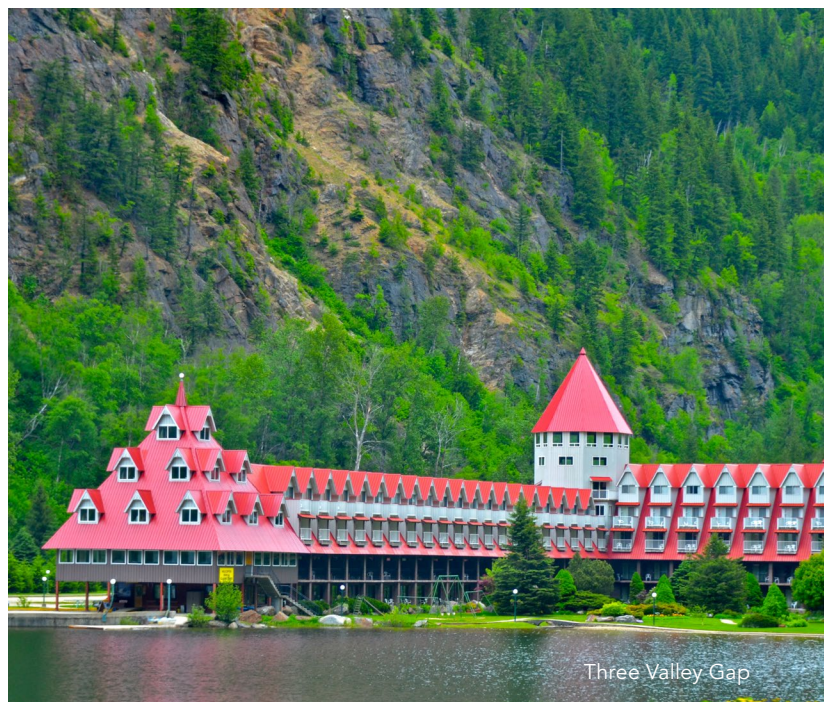

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Activity Level 1

Light Activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods, and walk at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. There is a short walk to the viewing platform atop Mount Mackenzie. Note the altitude of 1,700 metres (5,500 feet).

You may bring a walker or cane to support your mobility. Please let us know when you book if you will be bringing a walker on this tour. You can drop out of most activities and wait for the group to finish. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour.

ITINERARY

Tuesday, July 22

In Eagle Pass, we visit the **Three Valley Gap ghost town** which is full of authentic buildings moved here from other sites, plus the antique auto museum, the railway roundhouse, and the gardens. We stay three nights at Sutton Place Hotel at the foot of Revelstoke Mountain Resort. This deluxe hotel offers beautiful rooms, restaurant, outdoor pool, spa services, fitness centre, and wi-fi.

Meals included: Lunch, Dinner

Accommodation: Sutton Place Hotel

Wednesday, July 23

Revelstoke Mountain Resort opened as a ski resort in 2007 and now offers summer activities. We ride the gondola from near the hotel up to an altitude of 1,700 metres (5,500 feet). A stroll through blossoming alpine meadows leads to a viewing platform with panoramic vistas of the Columbia Valley, the Monashee Mountains, and Mount Begbie. If you feel like a short interpretive walk, a guide meets us there to point out some alpine flowers and talk about the mountain ecosystem.

Option: Instead of riding the gondola down the mountain, you can take the Pipe Mountain Coaster. It's a cart mounted on a single rail and you control your speed with a brake lever. This exhilarating ride is sure to get your adrenaline pumping as you speed through many twists and turns and even a tunnel for 1.4 km. \$25 per person plus GST. Please book by final payment.

In the afternoon, we visit the **Revelstoke Railway Museum** which has a fascinating collection of exhibits about the CPR.

Accommodation: Sutton Place Hotel

Thursday, July 24

The **Revelstoke Wildflower Festival** starts today, celebrating the beauty of the alpine bloom which usually peaks about now. In the morning, we go to Kovach Park to see the Invasive Species exhibit and enjoy the Wildflower Window walk through downtown. Afterwards, we drive east on the Trans-Canada Highway and take a pleasant forest stroll with interpretive signage at the Giant Cedars Boardwalk. We continue to **Canyon Hot Springs** for a relaxing time in the pools amid the scenery of the Illecillewaet Valley. Water from the natural spring is piped over 3 km to feed a 15,000 gallon hot pool and a 60,000 gallon swimming pool. The hot mineral soaking pool temperature is 40°C (104°F) and the swimming pool is 32°C (86°F).

Accommodation: Sutton Place Hotel

Friday, July 25

We take the ferry across the **Arrow Lakes** to Galena Bay, passing the flooded sites of lost towns such as Beaton and Arrowhead after the Keenleyside Dam was built. Lunch is in Nakusp, then we ride the Needles ferry and drive over Monashee Pass to return home.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due June 5, 2025. By paying the deposit, you agree to the [Terms & Conditions](#), Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (1.5% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Early Booking Bonus: Receive an \$80 discount on the first 15 seats and \$40 on the next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after June 5, 2025.

Cancellation Policy: Up to May 5, 2025, the cancellation charge is \$50 per person. From May 6 to June 5, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From June 6 to June 20, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. After June 20, there is no refund.

Itinerary and Fare Changes: Our many suppliers may notify us about changes to the itinerary prior to departure and sometimes during the tour. We do our best to substitute a similar service if something cancels, but occasionally the only alternative is to provide a refund for the missed activity. Please note that if we are forced to cancel a tour component due to an issue beyond our control, the current penalties still apply if you choose to cancel the entire tour. Fuel surcharges and changes to taxes or other tour costs can occur at any time, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up to departure.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own

snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. This tour stays in British Columbia. While your BC Services Card may cover you for a medical issue that arises during the tour, you will probably benefit from trip cancellation and trip interruption coverage in case of illness or a mishap before or during the tour. Many other benefits such as luggage insurance are included. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for cancellation, interruption, and luggage.
