Light Activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. Expect some stairs, mainly to and from your theatre seats. There is some walking at Burnaby Village Museum, and Fort Langley.

You may bring a walker or cane to support your mobility. Please let us know when you book if you will be bringing a walker on this tour. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour.

ITINERARY

Monday, September 1

Transportation is arranged to New Westminster. We stay at the Inn at the Quay, built on a pier jutting into the Fraser River. Every room has a view of the river and you can watch all the shipping traffic going by.

Meals included: Lunch

Tuesday, September 2

The morning is free time. Take a stroll along Westminster Quay or browse the shops in Westminster Market or along Columbia Street. This afternoon, we go to the **Burnaby Village Museum**, a recreated 1920s village, made up of heritage and replica buildings. Watch demonstrations at the forge in Wagner's Blacksmith Shop, learn from Indigenous educators and a Chinese herbalist, step inside the 1893 Love Farmhouse to learn about life on a family farm, climb aboard the 1912 interurban tram, and take a ride on the restored 1912 Parker Carousel. Later, we head downtown to the Queen Elizabeth Theatre and the curtain rises for **The Lion King** at 7:30 pm.

Accommodation: Inn at the Quay

Wednesday, September 3

The Hudson's Bay Company built **Fort Langley** beside the Fraser River in 1827. It traded furs with indigenous people and shipped them to Europe via Cape Horn, as well as providing produce to Russia and California. In 1858, the Fraser River gold rush caused a huge influx of Americans, so Governor James Douglas proclaimed a Crown Colony here. Today, Fort Langley National Historic Site interprets the influence of this strategic post on the province's history. Afterwards, we head for home with a lunch stop in Chilliwack.

THE LION KING

The Lion King opened on Broadway in 1997 and is still running after more than 10,000 performances. It is Broadway's third longest running show after *Phantom of the Opera* and *Chicago* and, in September 2014, it surpassed *Phantom* as the highest-grossing musical of all time and current revenue estimates are \$8 billion worldwide. In 1998, *The Lion King* swept the Drama Desk Awards with 11 nominations, winning 8 of them. It also won 6 Tony Awards including Best Musical. The show has played in many countries around the world. It ran for 4 years in Toronto in 2000-2004 and recently opened again in Toronto.

A touring production will be in Vancouver for 4 weeks in August and September. Treat yourself and your family to a memory that will last a lifetime enjoying the musical. Time Magazine calls "awe-inspiring! A gorgeous, gasp-inducing spectacle!" This is one of the best pieces of theatre you will ever see. This is *The Lion King*.

Wells Gray Tours has booked excellent seats at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre in Left Centre Orchestra, rows 16, 17, 18 and 19. Seats are assigned according to the order that customers book this tour.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due July 10, 2025. By paying the deposit, you agree to the [Terms & Conditions](#), Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (1.5% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Cancellation Policy: Up to June 9, 2025, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From June 10 to July 10, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit). From July 11 to July 30, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After July 30, there is no refund.

Itinerary and Fare Changes: Our many suppliers may notify us about changes to the itinerary prior to departure and sometimes during the tour. We do our best to substitute a similar service if something cancels, but occasionally the only alternative is to provide a refund for the missed activity. Please note that if we are forced to cancel a tour component due to an issue beyond our control, the current penalties still apply if you choose to cancel the entire tour. Fuel surcharges and changes to taxes or other tour costs can occur at any time, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up to departure.

Show cancellation: It rarely happens, but actors occasionally get sick, or some mishap causes the cancellation of a show. This can occur even shortly before the performance begins. We know that this would be extremely disappointing for our customers, but the only refund we would be able to obtain for you would be the actual ticket price of the show. The hotel, motorcoach, and other tour services are all prepaid and are non-refundable at short notice.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. This tour stays in British Columbia. While your BC Services Card may cover you for a medical issue that arises during the tour, you will probably benefit from trip cancellation and trip interruption coverage in case of illness or a mishap before or during the tour. Many other benefits such as luggage insurance are included. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for cancellation, interruption, and luggage.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.
