Your specific departure point will be confirmed at the time of booking. Passengers travelling from the BC Interior and Lower Mainland regions will begin and end the tour as follows:

BC Interior: We depart from the BC Interior on Sunday, December 21, and drive to Vancouver. We take the ferry to Victoria the following day. We return home on Friday, December 26, taking the ferry from Victoria to Tsawwassen. Transportation is provided from your pickup point on the day of

departure and back when we return.

Lower Mainland: Join this tour on Sunday, December 21 and stay with the group overnight in Vancouver. We take the ferry to Victoria the following day. We return home on Friday, December 26, taking the ferry from Victoria to Tsawwassen.

Departure from Vancouver: Home pickup for clients in the Greater Vancouver Area may be arranged at the time of booking.

Departure from Abbotsford or Chilliwack: Pickup and drop off are by the main coach. Please refer to the BC Interior tour fares.

Activity Level 1

Light Activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods, and walk breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. There are short distances to walk

at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. There are short distances to walk and some stairs such as to/from theatre seats and at Butchart Gardens.

You may bring a walker or cane to support your mobility. Please let us know when you book if you will be bringing a walker on this tour. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour.

Sunday, December 21

We drive to Vancouver and stay a night at the renowned **Fairmont Hotel Vancouver**. At 7:30 pm, we are at the Orpheum Theatre to enjoy a performance of *Traditional Christmas with the VSO*. Celebrate the holiday season as you gather to hear your favourite carols and Christmas music sung by special guest soloists and performed live by the VSO. Host Christopher Gaze will delight you with his characteristic antics and storytelling. A festive treat for all!

Monday, December 22

We take a morning ferry to Swartz Bay, then drive into downtown Victoria. This afternoon, we visit the Legislative Buildings and a guide shows us some of the grand public rooms with some history about these ornate buildings. Afterwards, we cruise around the Inner Harbour on the "Sleigh Boat Ride", admiring the fantasyland of Christmas lights. Later, we settle into the wonderful **Hotel Grand Pacific** for four nights. It has a great location on the Inner Harbour, next to the Legislative Buildings, and convenient to the shopping of Government and Douglas Streets. Hotel amenities include the Courtyard Café and Fathom Restaurant for dining, an indoor pool, fitness centre, and free Wi-Fi. Choose from three room types when you book this tour:

- **Standard Room** is a city-view room, usually facing south across the James Bay neighbourhood.
- **Signature Room** also has a city view with fancier furnishings and more amenities.
- **Harbourview Room** offers a great view of the Inner Harbour with all its activity, so you can watch boats and the ferry.

Dinner is in the Grand Pacific's ballroom.

Tuesday, December 23

The morning is free time. In the afternoon, we visit **Butterfly Gardens**, a tropical jungle with thousands of butterflies and other creatures. Afterwards, at the Butchart Festival of Lights, admire the dazzling Christmas lights, listen to traditional carollers and festive brass, and ride the carousel.

Wednesday, December 24 This morning, we explore the Royal BC Museum which has two special exhibitions during Christmas – Beyond the Beat: Music of Resistance and Change and Odysseys and Migration, as well as the popular permanent galleries. A show at the IMAX Theatre is included. At 3 pm, get together with your fellow travellers in the hotel ballroom. Christmas Eve dinner is at the Marriott Hotel followed by a concert presented by the Linden Singers Choir.

Payments: A deposit of \$300 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due October 23, 2025. By paying the deposit, you agree to the **Terms** & Conditions, Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (1.5% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

BC Seniors (65 & over): \$17 discount offered by BC Ferries. Please bring your BC Services Card on the tour.

Cancellation Policy: Up to September 23, 2025, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From September 24 to October 23, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person. From October 24 to November 7, the cancellation charge is 50% of the tour fare. From November 8 to November 20, the cancellation charge is 80% of tour fare. After November 20, there is no refund.

Itinerary and Fare Changes: Our many suppliers may notify us about changes to the itinerary prior to departure and sometimes during the tour. We do our best to substitute a similar service if something cancels, but occasionally the only alternative is to provide a refund for the missed activity. Please note that if we are forced to cancel a tour component due to an issue beyond our control, the current penalties still apply if you choose to cancel the entire tour. Fuel surcharges and changes to taxes or other tour costs can occur at any time, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up to departure.



Show cancellation: It rarely happens, but performers occasionally get sick, or some mishap causes the cancellation of a show. This can occur even shortly before the performance begins. We know that this would be disappointing for our customers, but the only refund we would be able to obtain for you would be the actual ticket price of the show. The hotel, motorcoach, and other tour services are all prepaid and are non-refundable at short notice.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. This tour stays in British Columbia. While your BC Services Card may cover you for a medical issue that arises during the

tour, you will probably benefit from trip cancellation and trip interruption coverage in case of illness or a mishap before or during the tour. Many other benefits such as luggage insurance are included. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for cancellation, interruption, and luggage.
