ROLAND'S RAMBLE

What a whirlwind summer it's been! I've probably added a few more gray hairs up top, thanks to Air Canada. When the strike was announced on August 13, we had a group flying to Toronto the next day to see three Blue Jays games and returning August 18. We couldn't cancel the tour because planes were still flying on August 13 and the hotel and game tickets were prepaid. It was the return flight that was in doubt. We managed to secure a Victoria flight on WestJet prior to the strike. When an agreement was reached, Air Canada rescheduled our Kelowna flight from August 18 to 23. We looked at WestJet, Porter, Flair, Transat, Air North, Sunwing and VIA Rail, but all were charging outrageous prices for the few available seats. We considered driving to Buffalo and flying to Seattle, but some people did not have passports. Then on August 18, after the remaining 21 people were planning on enjoying an extra five days in Toronto, Air Canada suddenly found seats that evening, and everybody got home, albeit with a couple of extra days in Toronto. It's a lesson in always buying travel insurance, but be sure it does not exclude strikes.

The other worry was our Scotland tour leaving August 20 with a flight to Toronto, then Edinburgh. Air Canada initially cancelled the Toronto flight and rebooked us on an exhausting flight from Vancouver to San Diego, Newark, and Edinburgh. The critical element was our tickets to the Edinburgh Military Tattoo on August 23, purchased a year ago because it is so popular. Almost at the last minute, the Toronto flight was reinstated and off they went to Edinburgh, on time. The tour has now returned, and by all accounts, they had a fabulous time.

All this was coordinated by Dom in Penticton, our Flights Specialist, and Sema in Victoria, Operations Manager. Thanks to them for their dedication, logging many hours of overtime on phones and computers to be sure that everyone got home or headed out on time. They may say they worked tirelessly, but I'm sure they were exhausted when this ordeal was over.

Anne and I are feeling very pleased about all the accomplishments in Wells Gray Park this summer. The naturalist program was a great success with record attendance at the walks and talks presented by Kendall and Sam. The trail crew, Aidan and Ethan,

cleared and improved some 200 km of Park trails and re-opened the nearly impassable Huntley Col trail. The Grove of Giants interpretive trail opened with nine new signs explaining the wonders of this old-growth forest enclave. All this was made possible by a donation to the BC Parks Foundation. You can do this as well and benefit your favourite park.

As we head into fall, I'm looking ahead excitedly to many activities. A Wells Gray Park tour in late September, a Mystery Tour in October, a 5th birthday party for our granddaughter and a 100th for a long-time friend, visits from our daughter at Thanksgiving and Christmas, and the National Tour Association convention in Ottawa. I guess it's time we decided on a winter holiday, as several of our tours are already full. Since I spend lots of time planning your tours, I'm not keen on planning a holiday for Anne and me when it's much easier to hop on a Wells Gray tour!

We don't have much planned south of the border this year because Canadians understandably are not crossing the border. Two exceptions stand out — a festive Christmas Lights trip to Leavenworth (departing from Victoria) and a relaxing Palm Springs Winter Escape in February 2026. We don't know when friendly relations will resume with the USA, could be next week, could be a year or two. The planning and promotion of a tour takes six to eight months before departure, so we want to be ready with a few USA tour offers.

And don't forget — our Annual Travel Shows return in October! Hosted by Kerrie, our Director of Sales & Marketing, this is how you can get a sneak preview of upcoming 2026 tours. Be sure to RSVP early, as space is limited. We've added extra shows in Kamloops and Kelowna because so many people want to attend. It's always such a joy to reconnect with familiar faces and welcome new friends to the Wells Gray family.




