ITINERARY

Saturday, November 21

We take a mid-afternoon ferry from Horseshoe Bay to Nanaimo.

Meals included: Lunch (BC Interior)

Accommodation: Coast Bastion Hotel

Sunday, November 22

We stroll the smooth sands at Rath Trevor Beach and walk among towering firs at **Cathedral Grove** (if conditions permit). After lunch in Port Alberni, we drive to the west coast of Vancouver Island. The next three nights are at **Wickaninnish Inn** near Tofino. Perched on a rocky point above Chesterman Beach, every room has a splendid ocean view. Maybe you will experience a thrilling storm where the spray lashes the windows while you are cuddled comfortably by the fireplace. The tides are extreme during our stay due to the full moon on November 24 – high tide today is 12.1 feet at 11:09 am and low tide is 1.8 feet at 6 pm. Dinner is included at the hotel's renowned restaurant, The Pointe, with a limited choice menu.

Monday, November 23

Breakfast is included at The Wick each day. High tide today is 12.7 feet at 11:49 am and low tide is 0.9 foot at 6:44 pm (plus one of each during the night). We drive into Tofino in late morning to visit the Tofino Clayoquot Heritage Museum, browse some shops, and have lunch (on own). The best beachcombing occurs during low tide, so this afternoon we visit **Long Beach**, the most popular feature of Pacific Rim National Park, and peer into some tidal pools. At the hotel, you should take a

stroll along Chesterman Beach. Dinner is on your own so you can enjoy another tasty experience at the hotel, or the coach provides a transfer into Tofino.

Tuesday, November 24

High tide today is 13.1 feet at 12:31 pm and low tides are 5.4 feet at 6:30 am and 0.4 foot at 7:31 pm. In the morning, we drive to **Wickaninnish Beach**, the south section of Long Beach, and search for any treasures left by the dropping tide. The afternoon is free time at the Wickaninnish Inn. Maybe you have an appointment at the Ancient Cedars Spa. Otherwise, enjoy the fitness centre or the beach. Dinner is served in The Pointe.

Wednesday, November 25

We return to the east coast of Vancouver Island with a stop for lunch in Parksville. A sumptuous buffet dinner is served at **Chemainus Theatre**, followed by the show *The Wickhams: Christmas at Pemberley*. Downton Abbey meets Jane Austen in this witty and wonderful *Pride and Prejudice* sequel to Chemainus' 2024 show. While the family celebrates upstairs, the servants in the downstairs quarters must deal with a shocking holiday scandal when Mr. Wickham, Darcy's nemesis and Lydia's spouse, stumbles in.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 1



Light activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods and walk at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. The amount of walking at Rathrevor Beach, Cathedral Grove, Long Beach, and Wickaninnish Beach is your choice.

You may bring a walker or cane to support your mobility. Please let us know when you book if you will be bringing a walker on this tour. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$250 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due September 16, 2026. By paying the deposit, you agree to the [Terms & Conditions](#), Activity Level and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (3% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

BC Seniors (65 & over): \$18 discount offered by BC Ferries. Please bring your BC Services Card on the tour.

Cancellation Policy: Up to August 14, 2026, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From August 15 to September 16, the cancellation charge is \$250 per person (your deposit). From September 17 to October 16, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare. After October 16, there is no refund.

Itinerary and Fare Changes: Our many suppliers may notify us about changes to the itinerary prior to departure and sometimes during the tour. We do our best to substitute a similar service if something cancels, but occasionally the only alternative is to provide a refund for the missed activity. Please note that if we are forced to cancel a tour component due to an issue beyond our control, the current penalties still apply if you choose to cancel the entire tour. Fuel surcharges and changes to taxes or other tour costs can occur at any time, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up to departure.

Show cancellation: It rarely happens, but actors occasionally get sick, or some mishap causes the cancellation of the Chemainus show. This can occur even shortly before the performance begins. We know that this would be disappointing for our customers, but the only refund we would be able to obtain for you would be the actual ticket price of the show. The hotels, motorcoach, and other tour services are all prepaid and are non-refundable at short notice.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. This tour goes to some remote places where restaurants may not be able to satisfy all food allergies. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. This tour stays in British Columbia. While your BC Services Card may cover you for a medical issue that arises during the tour, you will probably benefit from trip cancellation and trip interruption coverage in case of illness or a mishap before or during the tour. Many other benefits such as luggage insurance are included. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for cancellation, interruption, and luggage.
