Scenic Cruises has confirmed a block of suites for our 55th Anniversary Cruise and they will be held until October 2, 2026. River cruises are extremely popular and most are sold out long before departure, so you should not wait to book this tour. After all, the ship carries a maximum of 122 guests and it doesn't take long to sell out a small ship like *Scenic Gem*.

Some customers tell us that they don't like to book a tour over a year before departure because there could be health issues or family commitments that arise. If something changes up to 6 months before sailing, your cost to cancel is only \$100 per person. **On October 2, 2026, Scenic will recall our unsold suites and it is unlikely that we can secure more.**

SEINE RIVER

Seine River with Paris Old Town

The Seine is the elegant, slow-moving heart of northern France, and a seven-day cruise along its waters feels like drifting through a living postcard. Beginning in Paris, the river carries you past iconic landmarks—the Eiffel Tower, Notre-Dame, the Louvre—before guiding you into peaceful countryside dotted with orchards, châteaux, and medieval towns. As the scenery shifts from grand boulevards to quiet villages, the Seine reveals the layers of French history and culture that have inspired artists for centuries.

Along the route, we glide to Giverny, where Monet painted his luminous water lilies, and to Rouen, a Gothic masterpiece of spires and cobblestones. Further downstream, the river widens toward Normandy where dramatic coastal cliffs and poignant World War II sites offer powerful historical lessons. A week on the Seine blends romance, art, cuisine, and gentle exploration—perfect for travellers who want to savour France at an unhurried pace.

WELLS GRAY TOURS' 55TH ANNIVERSARY

Fifty-five years in business is an achievement for any company. Wells Gray Tours founder and owner Roland Neave and his staff have long recognized the importance of celebrating anniversaries at Wells Gray Tours. The first one was the 14th, held in Reno in 1986, then every year after that until 1997, the 25th. We considered a quarter century to be quite a milestone, so we chartered the *Rotterdam* from Holland America, filled it with 1,100 enthusiastic customers, and sailed away from Vancouver for a special cruise route to Ocean Falls. Roland still remembers being really nervous about signing that big cheque!

After 1997, anniversaries were planned every five years, so they seemed more special than doing it every year. The 30th travelled to Banff Springs Hotel on the Rocky Mountaineer train. The 35th, 40th and 45th were on cruise ships with many special Wells Gray activities and 700–800 customers participating.

The initial extravagant plans for the 50th in 2022 were shelved since the pandemic was ongoing. So we returned to our roots and re-created the first tours of Wells Gray Park from 1972–75, albeit taking three days to do what was once a day tour from Kamloops (and for a little more than \$5 per person). On May 20, 2023, 51 years to the day from the first Wells Gray Park tour, we boarded a private chartered vessel, *Emerald Radiance*, in Porto, Portugal, for a wonderful cruise on the Douro River.

In a few months, we will turn the calendar to 2027 and the 55th Anniversary will be on the horizon. Come and join Roland and Anne Neave and several staff on board *Scenic Gem* for this momentous Wells Gray occasion.



MV SCENIC GEM

The *Gem* is one of Scenic Cruises' most intimate and innovative ships, custom-designed in 2014 specifically to navigate the winding, shallow stretches of the Seine River, including areas inaccessible to larger vessels. Its unique size and engineering allow guests to sail deeper into Normandy, right to the charming town of Honfleur, making it a standout choice for travellers seeking a more immersive French river experience. The ship was completely renovated in 2024.

Scenic Cruises is often ranked among the top three river cruise companies along with Tauck and Uniworld. "Setting the benchmark for truly all-inclusive river cruising since 2008" is Scenic's own descriptive slogan. You can be assured that "all-inclusive" really does mean "no hidden costs", so you don't have to present your credit card frequently as with many other cruise lines.

On board, *Scenic Gem* blends contemporary elegance with all-inclusive luxury. Its 61 suites (not called staterooms or cabins) offer a boutique-hotel feel with plush bedding, spacious bathrooms, and personal butler service for every guest. All but four feature Scenic Sun Lounges which transform private balconies into all-weather relaxation spaces. Dining is a highlight with four venues offered — the refined Crystal Dining Room, L'Amour with a 5-course menu and only 32 guests per evening, the casual River Cafe, and the exclusive Table La Rive tasting experience one evening for guests in the four Royal Suites. You can also order a complimentary in-suite dining experience.

The ship's public spaces are designed for comfort and connection: Panorama Lounge and bar, a wellness area with massage services, a small gym, a soaking pool, walking track, and a top deck with sun beds and chaise longues perfect for watching the French countryside drift by. Wi-Fi is complimentary. The floor to ceiling windows and French balconies on the Sapphire and Diamond decks make for bright suites with a contemporary design. Comfort is essential — dress code is relaxed and casual except the Welcome and Farewell dinners are a little dressier. Dining has open seating with no reserved tables. You can choose a buffet or menu for breakfast in the dining room, or a light breakfast in the lounge. All beverages are complimentary 24 hours a day. Your cruise director keeps you informed about the daily entertainment, the upcoming lectures on ports of call, and various on-board activities to enrich your Seine experience. Several complimentary tours are offered at each stop and you should choose based on your activity level. Some of these tours are on a motorcoach and some are walking tours.

There are seven categories of suites:

- **Category E suites** on the Jewel or lowest deck have portholes and measure 160 square feet. Only four are available.
- **Categories C and BD suites** are on Sapphire Deck. Categories PA, P and PD are on Diamond Deck. They measure 205-225 square feet. All have floor to ceiling windows and the French balcony changes from an indoor to outdoor space with ease as the window lowers to a halfway point at the touch of a button.
- **Category R (Royal Balcony Suites)** are on Diamond Deck and measure 305 square feet. Beautifully appointed with a private balcony, these fancy suites have separate bedroom and sitting areas. Unlimited complimentary laundry, shoeshine, valet, in-suite breakfast service, canapés before dinner, and after-dinner treats are included. Only two suites are available.

With its intimate atmosphere, attentive crew, and thoughtful design, *Scenic Gem* delivers a seamless blend of luxury and discovery along the Seine.

ITINERARY

Friday, October 1

Your departure point will be discussed at the time of booking. Flights leave Vancouver, Victoria, and Kelowna Airport in the afternoon and it's an overnight flight to Paris.

Saturday, October 2

We arrive in Paris about noon and our guide, coach, and driver are waiting. **Welcome to France!** Paris, the City of Light, is living history and full of amazing landmarks — Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysées, Eiffel Tower, Louvre Museum, the Left Bank, Opéra Garnier, and Notre-Dame Cathedral. We stay three nights at the 4-star **Hilton Paris Opera**. Housed in a historic 19th century building, the hotel features charming Haussmann-style architecture and a grand lobby with glass roof. It is located close to the department stores on Boulevard Haussmann. After arrival, a walking orientation tour helps you discover points of interest in the area. Meet your fellow travellers during a get-acquainted dinner.

Sunday, October 3

The **Palace of Versailles** has been on UNESCO's World Heritage List for 45 years and is one of the most magnificent achievements of 18th-century French art. The site began as Louis XIII's hunting lodge before his son Louis XIV transformed and expanded it, moving the court and government of France to Versailles in 1682. Each of the three French kings who lived there until the French Revolution added improvements to make it more beautiful. Our visit includes the State Apartments and the splendid Hall of Mirrors.

Monday, October 4

We enjoy a guided tour of **Montmartre**, an iconic Parisian district with picturesque alleyways, Place du Tertre, and the Sacré-Coeur Basilica. Open since 1793, the **Louvre Museum** has embodied

the concept of a truly universal institution. The priceless artworks housed in the Louvre are held for the benefit of present and future generations. The 35,000 works include such famous masterpieces as Mona Lisa, the Winged Victory of Samothrace, and the Venus de Milo. This evening, we visit the illuminated **Eiffel Tower** and ride the elevator to the observatory level. Tickets for both the Louvre Museum and the Eiffel Tower cannot be secured until closer to our visit, so these attractions are subject to availability.

Tuesday, October 5

We participate in a cooking class to discover the flavours and tips of French cuisine. We board **Scenic Gem** in the afternoon, settle into our suites, home for the next seven nights, and explore the four decks of the ship. Gather in the Panorama Lounge for a welcome beverage, then our first succulent meal in the dining room is served. Later this evening, we cast off and start sailing down the beautiful Seine.

Wednesday, October 6

We awaken docked in **Conflans-Saint Honorine**, a medieval town located at the confluence of the rivers Seine and Oise. Though it's just a short distance from the city centre, it feels a world away. A castle was built here by monks in the 9th century to protect the relics of Saint Honorine from whom the town gets its name. It became a popular pilgrimage site in the 11th century, a practice which lasted for more than 700 years. Wander the quiet streets and the riverside pathway, sip coffee at an open-air cafe, and admire the beautiful ancient church. Choose from three complimentary tours:

Thursday, October 7

Normandy's capital, **Rouen**, has a history that spans over 2000 years, from Viking legends to its significant role in both world wars. It was also the place where Richard the Lionheart was crowned Duke of Normandy and Joan of Arc was burned at the stake. Much of Rouen was sadly destroyed in World War II, however the city has been faithfully restored, including the exquisite Old Town. It's an engaging and historically rich destination, packed with museums, stylish bistros and coffee shops, and a wealth of churches, including the famed 12th century Rouen Cathedral. Back on board this evening, history comes alive with an engaging lecture about Operation Fortitude and the daily life of Honfleur's citizens during the D-Day campaign in World War II. Choose from three complimentary tours:

- Guided tour of Rouen with 'Rollo the Viking'
- In the footsteps of Joan of Arc

Friday, October 8

Honfleur is a colourful port city on the edge of the English Channel. The specially designed *Scenic Gem* is able to cruise even further into this harbour that is renowned as one of Europe's most picturesque and this allows shorter transfers to today's excursions. Over the years the town has captured the imaginations of countless artists and was the birthplace of Impressionism. The bustling harbour and cobbled streets are a confection of half-timbered houses, restaurants, gourmet shops and art galleries. It's an easy walk from the ship to explore the harbour area and network of laneways beyond. An hour's drive away is **Juno Beach**, the famous site of D-Day, where Canadian battalions landed on June 6, 1944. Choose between two complimentary tours:

- Excursion to the Normandy Beaches including Juno Beach Centre with a focus on Canadian history
- Walking tour of Honfleur

Saturday, October 9

We start heading upstream on the Seine with different stops. We arrive in the small town of **Caudebec-en-Caux** early this morning. Set on a curve of the Seine, the riverfront is lined with handsome homes, stately gardens and crumbling stone walls. Caudebec-en-Caux dates back to the Middle Ages and a handful of historic buildings survived the bombardments of WWII, including the ornate 15th century Notre-Dame Caudebec-en-Caux. Choose from four complimentary tours:

- Fecamp and Benedictine Palace
- Normandy Abbey Road
- Cycle to Villequier with Victor Hugo Museum
- Lillebonne tour

Sunday, October 10

Historically a border town between the Duchy of Normandy and the Kingdom of France, Vernon has a rich heritage and many distinctive buildings. Nearby Giverny was the home of Impressionist artist **Claude Monet** for more than 40 years. This afternoon, we cruise towards Chateau de La Roche Guyon where this evening's exclusive classical concert takes place beside the Seine. Choose between two complimentary tours in Vernon:

- Monet's House and Garden
- Self-guided cycle from Vernon to Giverny

Monday, October 11

In the morning, we cruise up the Seine and return to **Paris** where you can spend the afternoon exploring different aspects of this iconic city. First-timers may prefer the highlights tour, which allows you to visit renowned sites such as the Eiffel Tower and Notre-Dame Cathedral, while those rediscovering Paris may enjoy the trendy Marais District or venture just south of Paris and explore Chateau de Vaux-le-Vicomte. *Scenic Gem* stays docked in Paris overnight, giving you a chance to soak up the atmosphere of the 'City of

Light' and explore the glistening lights after dark. Choose from three complimentary afternoon tours:

We disembark *Scenic Gem* in the morning and travel to the Paris airport. Our flight home leaves in mid-afternoon with connections to Kelowna, Victoria and Vancouver.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 2



Moderate activity: As a traveller you like a variety of activities and walking up to 2 km with breaks such as a guided walking tour is very doable for you without assistance. You can stand for prolonged periods, negotiate a variety of terrain

from cobblestone streets to moderate hills comfortably, and can climb two flights of stairs without assistance. Book shore excursions based on your mobility. There are some shore excursions and pre-cruise tours that could be rated as [Activity Level 3](#). **You must handle your own luggage at airports and often walk long distances. You may need to handle your own luggage at the Paris hotel if luggage service is not available.**

You may bring a cane or walking poles if needed. This tour is not appropriate for people who require the use of a walker. The coaches cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour. In extreme situations, you may be required to leave the tour and travel home at your own expense; travel insurance will probably not cover you.

TOUR & CRUISE NOTES

Documentation: A passport is required with an expiry date at least 6 months after you return to Canada. A visa is not required for a Canadian to enter France. The European Union is implementing a European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS), and it is scheduled to begin sometime in 2027. ETIAS is the new travel authorisation for visa-exempt travellers to enter 30 European countries. More information and instructions will be provided at final payment if available.

Currency & expenses: The Euro is the currency of France. As of July 2026, one Euro costs C\$1.63. You should order Euros from your bank 1-2 weeks before departure, or plan to use ATMs. Credit cards are accepted almost everywhere. As this tour has been planned and priced 15 months before departure, it is possible that exchange fluctuations between the Canadian dollar and the Euro could affect the fare, in which case you will be notified of the increase or decrease. Your purchases on the ship are charged in Euros.

Gratuities are included for the Paris guides, coach drivers, and guides and drivers for the ship's shore excursions. The standard crew gratuities on board the ship are included, but a gratuity is expected for spa services. Gratuities to the Wells Gray tour director and Canadian drivers are not included and left to your discretion.

Flight seating: We are unable to take requests for window or aisle seating on the planes in any class. The airline will not accept them, as group seating is assigned as a block. If this is important to you, we suggest you take the "No Flight" option with a fare reduction that can be quoted in late November 2026 and book your own flight which allows seat selection. Please see our [Terms and Conditions](#) for more information on the "No Flight" option.

Flight upgrades: Please enquire about current prices for upgrades on the flights to and from Paris. Business class may be available. Quotes available in late November 2026.

Flight delays or cancellations: In the event flights are delayed or cancelled by airlines due to weather or other reasons, there may be additional costs to you. Wells Gray Tours will not pay for hotel rooms and meals during the delay. Most travel insurance policies cover expenses incurred for flight delays.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. During the pre-cruise touring, some restaurants may not be able to satisfy all food allergies. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. Most food allergies can be handled at meals on the ship, but you may have to order 24 hours in advance. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Rooms for singles are often a different style or smaller size than twin rooms in hotels (not on ship). The Paris hotel may limit the number of single rooms for a group. Please book early if you prefer to travel single.

Triples are not available on this tour.



TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$1,000 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due May 26, 2027. By paying the deposit, you agree to the [Terms and Conditions](#), Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (3% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Early booking bonus: Receive a \$300 discount on all reservations until October 2, 2026. The discount is not offered after that.

Cancellation Policy:

- Up to April 1, 2027, your tour payments are refunded less a cancellation charge of \$100 per person.
- From April 2 to May 26, the cancellation charge is \$700 per person.
- From May 27 to June 25, the cancellation charge is 80% of the tour fare.
- After June 25, there is no refund.

Itinerary and Fare Changes: Our many suppliers may notify us about changes to the itinerary prior to departure and sometimes during the tour. We do our best to substitute a similar service if something cancels, but occasionally the only alternative is to provide a refund for the missed activity. Please note that if we are forced to cancel a tour component due to an issue beyond our control, the current penalties still apply if you choose to cancel the entire tour. As this tour has been planned 1½ years in advance, changes to foreign currency exchange rates and taxes, and surcharges from airlines, the cruise ship, and other tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours. The flight cannot be booked until 11 months before the return date (November 2026), so the included air fare has been estimated based on 2026 fares and could change.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard until September 8, 2026 and Battleface after that. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for medical, cancellation, interruption, and luggage. Please do not travel outside British Columbia without medical insurance as a minimum. Insurance premiums are not refundable whether or not you make a claim.
