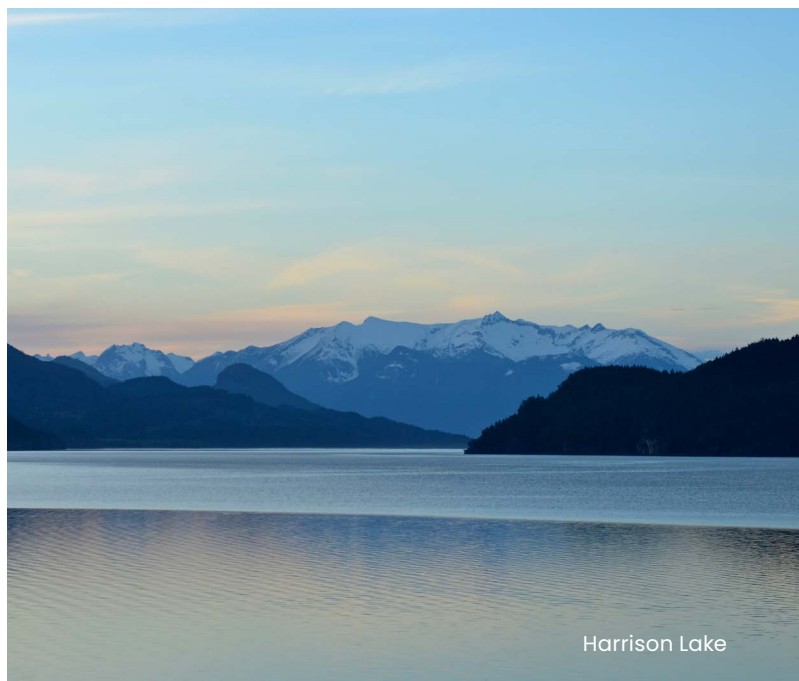

DEPARTURE INFORMATION

Your departure point will be discussed at the time of booking.



Vancouver Island: We depart on Tuesday, February 16, and take the ferry from Nanaimo to Horseshoe Bay. We return home on Friday, February 19, taking the ferry from Tsawwassen to Swartz Bay.

Departure from Victoria: Designated pickup points are offered in the Greater Victoria Area. Home pickups may be offered in the Greater Victoria Area to the first 10 passengers for an additional cost.

Departure from Up-island: Designated pickup points are offered for departure on February 16 to meet the coach in Nanaimo. Drop off up-island will be via Victoria on February 19.



Lower Mainland: We depart on Tuesday, February 16 and drive to Harrison Hot Springs. We drive home on Friday, February 19.

Departure from Vancouver: Home pickup for clients in the Greater Vancouver Area may be arranged at the time of booking.

Departure from Langley, Abbotsford, or Chilliwack: Designated points for pickup and drop off are offered.

ITINERARY

Tuesday, February 16

We take a morning ferry from Departure Bay in Nanaimo to Horseshoe Bay, then drive through the Fraser Valley to Harrison Hot Springs. A delectable **afternoon tea** is served at Karen's Café. Our accommodation at **Harrison Hot Springs Resort** is booked in the East Tower. All guestrooms feature floor-to-ceiling windows with views of Harrison Lake, balconies, refrigerators, free Wi-Fi, and complimentary bathrobes for use during your stay. Dinner is in the Lakeside Café.

Wednesday, February 17

Harrison's extensive buffet breakfast is served in the Lakeside Café each day. Today is at leisure to do as you wish. Of course, the hot springs are an enticing and soothing pastime and are open all day and evening. Otherwise, consider scheduling a treatment at the exquisite Healing Springs Spa with services that range from facials and massages to full body care packages. Take a walk along the lakeshore trails. There are plenty of activities to engage you today.

Thursday, February 18

We visit **Kilby Store Historic Site**, a wonderful restoration of a century-old general store and farm. Included is an interior tour of the store, a walk around the farm, and the delightful show *Victorian Secrets* which incorporates humour, music, and many 'revealing' surprises. The afternoon is free time for the hot pools or spa appointments.

Afternoon Option – Sasquatch Museum

Exhibits describe this shadowy creature and Sasquatch expert Thomas Steenberg talks about the myths and lore. Cost is \$10 per person including transportation. Please choose this option before final payment. Only 22 seats are available.

This evening, join the group for an elegant dinner in the renowned **Copper Room** with live music and dancing.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 1



Light activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods and walk at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. There is a 10-minute walk to Karen's Café, plus some walking at Kilby Store Historic Site.

You may bring a walker or cane to support your mobility. Please let us know when you book if you will be bringing a walker on this tour. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$150 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due December 29, 2026. By paying the deposit, you agree to the [Terms & Conditions](#), Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (3% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Early Booking Bonus: Receive an \$80 discount on the first 15 seats and \$40 on the next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after December 29, 2026.

BC Seniors (Vancouver Island, 65 & over): \$18 discount offered by BC Ferries. Please bring your BC Services Card on the tour.

Cancellation Policy: Up to November 30, 2026, the cancellation charge is \$50 per person. From December 1 to December 29, the cancellation charge is \$150 per person (your deposit). From December 30, 2026 to January 15, 2027, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare. After January 15, there is no refund.

Itinerary and Fare Changes: Our many suppliers may notify us about changes to the itinerary prior to departure and sometimes during the tour. We do our best to substitute a similar service if something cancels, but occasionally the only alternative is to provide a refund for the missed activity. Please note that if we are forced to cancel a tour component due to an issue beyond our control, the current penalties still apply if you choose to cancel the entire tour. Fuel surcharges and changes to taxes or other tour costs can occur at any time, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up to departure.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard until September 8, 2026 and Battleface after that. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. This tour stays in British Columbia. While your BC Services Card may cover you for a medical issue that arises during the tour, you will probably benefit from trip cancellation and trip interruption coverage in case of illness or a mishap before or during the tour. Many other benefits such as luggage insurance are included. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for cancellation, interruption, and luggage.
