Light Activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods and walk at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance. The Chinatown walking tour is about 90 minutes and 4 blocks at a leisurely pace, but is not suitable for anybody with mobility challenges (opt out for a fare reduction of \$16). You may need to handle your own luggage at the hotel if luggage service is not available.

You may bring a walker or cane to support your mobility. Please let us know when you book if you will be bringing a walker on this tour. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour.

ITINERARY

Thursday, March 18

Your departure point will be discussed at the time of booking. We drive to Vancouver and stay two nights at the **Blue Horizon Hotel**. It has an excellent location on Robson Street, surrounded by dozens of interesting shops and restaurants, and a short walk to Pacific Centre Mall.

Friday, March 19

This morning, a local expert conducts a historical **walking tour of Chinatown**, featuring bright facades, street markets, and unique architecture. The walking distance is about four blocks, at a very leisurely pace with many stops and lasts 90 minutes. This is one of the largest Chinatowns of its kind in North America.

Option: You can opt out of this walk for a fare reduction of \$16; please decide no later than final payment date.

An early dinner is included on the 31st floor of the hotel with a terrific view. Tonight at 7:30pm, the curtain rises at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre for the awesome performance by **Shen Yun**.

Saturday, March 20

This morning we visit the **Chinese Canadian Museum** which is dedicated to celebrating the Chinese Canadian community. It is located in the Wing Sang Building. Originally built in 1889 by a Chinese merchant Yip Sang, the building is the oldest brick structure in Vancouver's Chinatown and housed his growing family of three wives and 23 children! Afterwards, we head for home with a lunch stop in Hope.

SHEN YUN — REVIVING 5,000 YEARS OF CIVILIZATION

Shen Yun Performing Arts is a premier classical Chinese dance and music company established in New York in 2006. It performs classical Chinese dance, ethnic and folk dance, and story-based dance, and orchestral accompaniment. For 5,000 years, divine culture flourished in the land of China. Humanity's treasure was nearly lost in the 20th century, but through breathtaking music and dance, *Shen Yun* is reviving this glorious culture. *Shen Yun* can be translated as "the beauty of divine beings dancing." The 40 dancers perform wearing intricate costumes, often accompanied by a variety of props. Some costumes are intended to imitate the dress of various ethnicities, while others depict ancient Chinese court dancers, soldiers, or characters from classic stories. Props include colourful handkerchiefs, drums, fans, chopsticks, or silk scarves. Each *Shen Yun* piece is set against a digitally projected backdrop, usually depicting landscapes such as Mongolian grasslands, imperial courts, ancient villages, temples, or mountains.

Shen Yun has eight performance troupes, each a large performing ensemble. These eight companies tour the world, performing in over 130 cities across multiple continents. Vancouver is one of five Canadian cities (the others are in Ontario) hosting *Shen Yun*. We have excellent seats at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre in Centre Orchestra. Seats are assigned according to the order that you book for this tour. Don't miss this incredible performance!

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due January 27, 2027. By paying the deposit, you agree to the [Terms and Conditions](#), Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (3% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Early Booking Bonus: Receive a \$50 discount on the first 15 seats and \$25 on the next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after January 27, 2027.

Cancellation Policy:

- Up to December 29, 2026, the cancellation charge is \$50 per person.
- From December 30, 2026 to January 27, 2027, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit).
- From January 28 to February 17, the cancellation charge is 60% of the tour fare.
- After February 17, there is no refund.

Show cancellation: It rarely happens, but performers occasionally get sick, or some mishap causes the cancellation of a show. This can occur even shortly before the performance begins. We know that this would be disappointing for our customers, but the only refund we would be able to obtain for you would be the actual ticket price of the show. The hotel, motorcoach, and other tour services are all prepaid and are non-refundable at short notice.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by Travel Guard until September 8, 2026 and Battleface after that. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. This tour stays in British Columbia. While your BC Services Card may cover you for a medical issue that arises during the tour, you will probably benefit from trip cancellation and trip interruption coverage in case of illness or a mishap before or during the tour. Many other benefits such as luggage insurance are included. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for cancellation, interruption, and luggage. Insurance premiums are not refundable whether or not you make a claim.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Experience Points or E-points: This tour earns 30 e-points. Each time you travel on a Wells Gray tour, you earn e-points that are added to your account after the tour returns. One e-point equals \$1.
