ROLAND'S RAMBLE

May 20 was a day of reflection for me and many Wells Gray staff. That was 54 years since the first Wells Gray tour headed out. And guess where it went – to Wells Gray Park north of Kamloops. It was a one-day tour and we charged \$5 per person including a picnic lunch and dinner. I had a mission along with members of the environmental organization STRRADA – to save the Park from BC Hydro building 7 dams on the Clearwater River and partly flooding Helmcken Falls. We stopped the dams, but I had no idea back in 1972 that the experience of showing people around Wells Gray Park would launch a lifetime career.

Next year will be Wells Gray Tours' 55th Anniversary and, every 5 years, we offer a special tour to celebrate. The plan is still being worked out, but it looks like you should set aside early October 2027 for 2 weeks. The tour will be limited to about 100 participants and it will be a cruise somewhere.

Anne and I got home on May 13 from our 63rd Mystery Tour which went to Serbia, Bosnia and Croatia for 12 days. What a marvellous destination! We flew to Belgrade, then travelled to the mountain resort of Zlatibor, and on to Sarajevo. We flew home from Dubrovnik. There is so much history along this route and tragedies too, like the Siege of Sarajevo from 1992–1996. This tour will be repeated as a regular one, probably in 2028, and will be 3 days longer to make it more leisurely. Every May, Wells Gray Tours donates \$50,000 to an organization with the stipulation that it must benefit the environment or conservation or have an educational focus. The donation cycles among our five offices and this year it is Penticton's turn. We received a proposal from the BC Parks Foundation for four intriguing projects, and Shelley and Dom in our Penticton office decided to split the donation between two of them. Learning by Nature received \$30,000; it's a program to develop small nature parks on South Okanagan school grounds and empower K–12 students to design and lead restoration projects. Marron Grasslands received \$20,000 towards protecting 77 acres of native grasslands near Kaleden. Wells Gray Tours is very proud to be supporting such beneficial projects. If you want to donate to your favourite park, go to www.bcparksfoundation.ca and click on the "Give" button; you will receive a charitable receipt.

Christmas tours are out for sale now. It is hard to think about Christmas when we are enjoying the early summer heat. Lots of customers are booking already, so come and join them. We have 5 departures: Christmas in Mexico, Christmas in Vancouver, Christmas in Victoria, and a 13-day tour combining Victoria and Vancouver for those who want to be away for Christmas and New Year's. Or try Turkey & Tinsel in Victoria in early December for those who prefer to be at home or with relatives 3 weeks later.

Most years, we feature one of Adventure Canada's exciting cruise itineraries through remote Arctic waters. In July 2027, we will offer their new ship *Ocean Victory* on a 13-day wilderness voyage from Reykjavik along Greenland's east coast, exploring dramatic fjords and glaciers. We will go ashore by Zodiacs and enjoy talks from expedition staff with expertise in Arctic geology, glaciation, history, Inuit culture, marine life, birds, and plants. Anne and I will join you, as these voyages are among our favourites.
