ROLAND'S RAMBLE

What a whirlwind summer it's been! I can hardly believe it is September already. Next week, I will be directing the Fall Mystery Tour to somewhere exciting in Canada. Solutions to the clues in the next newsletter!

On September 8, we will start selling battleface® travel insurance. This comprehensive policy is identical to our previous carrier, the most valuable benefit for older customers being the waiver of the pre-existing condition clause if you buy the policy at deposit and again at final payment. The premium is just 9.88% of your tour fare plus \$17.61 for the medical upgrade which provides up to \$2.5 million of coverage for medical care anywhere. This covers all ages up to 100 which should be sufficient because I can recall (fondly) only one customer who travelled until she was 101. Our previous policy was 6% of your fare higher, so this is quite a bargain. I urge you to always purchase travel insurance, even for short tours in BC.

Flight or ferry delays or cancellations, lost luggage, sudden illness, or a mishap are all unexpected travel events which can cause major disruption. Airlines try to avoid compensating you with excuses such as weather and this can get expensive such as a delay in Vancouver in the summer where a hotel room can cost \$300 to \$500. Travel insurance should cover this and filing a claim is much easier than fighting the airline or the Canadian Transportation Agency.

It's important to read your travel insurance policy. We often hear customers say they have insurance through their credit card and don't need ours, but do you know what your coverage is? Yes, it's 30 pages of fine print, but \$10,000 vs \$2.5 million medical coverage is quite a difference. Many customers carry Medoc insurance (including my wife and me), now called Belair, but it has a cancellation coverage limit of \$8,000 (battleface® is \$50,000).

"battleface" is an unusual name for any company and a lower-case 'b' is correct. It was founded to provide insurance for journalists reporting from dangerous situations "in the face of battle".

Everybody knows that travel costs have changed dramatically. Since Covid, the cost of hotels, flights, fuel, transportation, and dining has increased a lot which of course affects the price of our tours. For example, this year's Newfoundland tour had airfare of \$840, in 2027 it will be \$1,474. Our tour planners continue to focus on providing excellent

accommodations, quality restaurants, superior motorcoaches, and carefully planned itineraries. We always search for the best value and affordable seasons to travel.

Our goal remains the same: to create exceptional travel experiences while providing the quality, comfort, and service you have come to expect from Wells Gray Tours. Many factors are involved in pricing a tour, so we can continue to be successful and offer 95 tours a year to destinations all over the world. I'm grateful that you are travelling with us!

Birgy from the Kelowna office and Dom from Penticton returned recently from a week-long cruise on the *Scenic Gem* on the Seine River. They were invited by Scenic Cruises to check out the ship for our 55th Anniversary cruise in October 2027. They were totally wowed by the pampering service, superb cuisine, fine wines, quality shore excursions, and elegant suites. We have chartered the ship, so it will be a Wells Gray exclusive on board. There are only 3 suites left! Kerrie has promised she won't talk about all 80 tours currently available, but it will still be an entertaining presentation with plenty of travel ideas, great prizes, and a few laughs along the way.

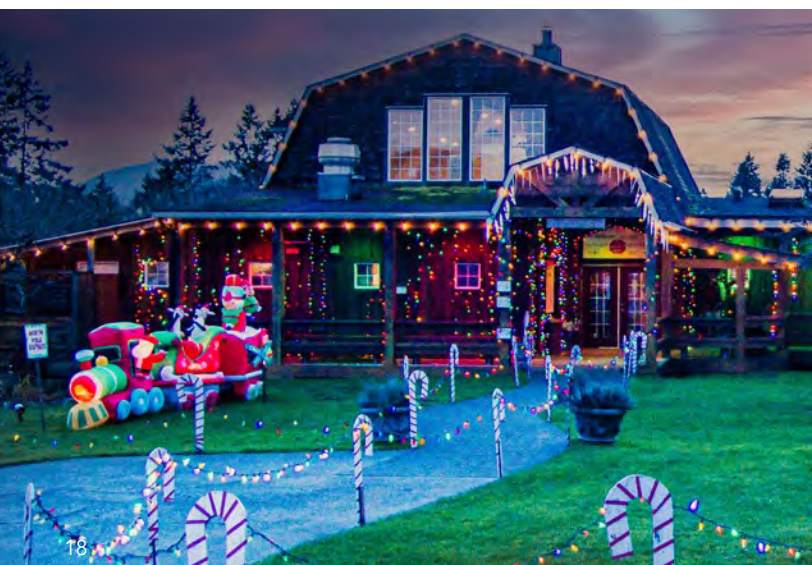

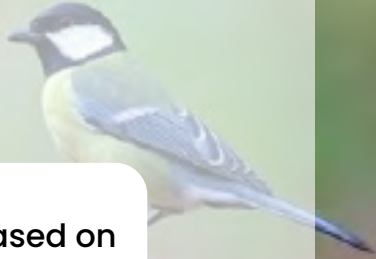
