Light Activity: You are a traveller who prefers to see places without a lot of physical activity. You can climb a flight of stairs, board a coach, stand for short periods, and walk at a leisurely pace with breaks for up to 30 minutes without difficulty or assistance.

You may bring a walker or cane to support your mobility. Please let us know when you book if you will be bringing a walker on this tour. The coach cannot carry a scooter or motorized wheelchair. The tour director and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them, or your fellow travellers, to provide ongoing assistance. If you are not capable of keeping up with the group or require frequent assistance, the tour director may stop you from participating in some activities or some days of the tour.

ITINERARY

Monday, February 22

Your [departure point](#) will be discussed at the time of booking. We stop for lunch in Parksville, where passengers from further up-island join us, then drive to the West Coast of Vancouver Island.

We stay three nights at the awesome **Wickaninnish Inn** near Tofino. Perched on a rocky point above Chesterman Beach, every room has a splendid ocean view. Maybe you will experience a thrilling storm where the spray lashes the windows while you are cuddled comfortably by the fireplace. High tide is at 2:31 pm, before arrival, so your first beach stroll is during a dropping tide. Dinner is included at the hotel's renowned restaurant, The Pointe, with a limited choice menu.

Tuesday, February 23

Breakfast is included at The Wick each day. Today's tides are 2.6 feet at 9:15 am and 11.6 feet at 3:17 pm. The best beachcombing occurs during low tide, so this morning we visit Long Beach, the most popular feature of **Pacific Rim National Park**. Take a stroll on the sandy beach and peer into some tidal pools. We drive into

Tofino at noon to have lunch (on own), visit the Tofino Clayoquot Heritage Museum, and browse some shops. Back at the hotel, enjoy a walk along Chesterman Beach. Dinner is on your own so you can savour another tasty experience at the hotel, or the coach provides a transfer into Tofino.

Wednesday, February 24

Today's tides are 2.6 feet at 10:00 am and 10.8 feet at 4:04 pm. In the morning, we drive to **Wickaninnish Beach**, the south section of Long Beach, and search for any treasures brought in by the high tide. The afternoon is free time at the Wickaninnish Inn. Maybe you have an appointment at the Ancient Cedars Spa. Otherwise, enjoy the fitness centre or a stroll on the beach. Dinner is served in The Pointe.

Thursday, February 25

Low tide is at 10:47 am. After a relaxed morning at the Wickaninnish Inn, we head to Port Alberni and have lunch. We then travel home to your pickup point. The coach travels south from Parksville, while a different transfer vehicle is arranged to transfer any passengers further north.

TOUR POLICIES

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and balance is due December 10, 2026. By paying the deposit, you agree to the [Terms and Conditions, Company Policies](#), Activity Level, and Cancellation Policy outlined. Payments can be made by online banking or cheque (3% discount on tour fare), or by Visa or Mastercard.

Early Booking Bonus: Receive a \$150 discount on the first 12 seats and \$75 on the next 8 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after December 10, 2026.

Cancellation Policy:

- Up to November 10, 2026, the cancellation charge is \$50 per person.
- From November 11 to December 10, the cancellation charge is \$200 per person (your deposit).
- From December 11, 2026 to January 11, 2027, the cancellation charge is 70% of the tour fare.
- After January 11, there is no refund.

Food Allergies: You must notify us no later than at final payment if you have a food allergy. An allergy causes medical distress, a preference does not. For some allergies, please consider bringing your own snacks or food items so you are not dependent on what restaurants are able to serve.

Travel Insurance: A Comprehensive Insurance policy is available through Wells Gray Tours and coverage is provided by battleface® travel insurance. Policies purchased at deposit include a waiver of the pre-existing condition clause for medical and cancellation claims, otherwise policies can be purchased no later than at final payment. This tour stays in British Columbia. While your BC Services Card may cover you for a medical issue that arises during the tour, you will probably benefit from trip cancellation and trip interruption coverage in case of illness or a mishap before or during the tour. Many other benefits such as luggage insurance are included. Medical questionnaire is not needed. Please contact us for details. If you have your own travel insurance, please read the policy carefully to be sure that you are adequately covered for cancellation, interruption, and luggage. Insurance premiums are not refundable whether or not you make a claim.
